SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, H. D. Schwarz, Jr., and Louis C. Lechenger, each, individually, and as Coexecutors of the Estate of Esther Hirsch Schwarz, deceased; Lois S. Rottersmann; Charlotte S. Friedmann; Pauline L. Morgenstern; are the owners of lands purchased from the State of Texas in Webb County, Texas, being more fully described as follows:

The ^{SOUTH?} ~~North~~ Half of Survey No. 75, Abstract 2694, Andrea J. de Alexander, original grantee, containing 319.76 acres; all of Survey No. 76, Abstract 2695, Andrea J. de Alexander, original grantee, containing 497.71 acres, more or less, in Webb County, Texas;

About which a dispute has arisen with the State of Texas and in particular the General Land Office as to the ownership of coal and lignite under such lands; and

WHEREAS, The above named owners allege that they are the owners of coal and lignite under this property rather than the State of Texas and that they are fully and exclusively empowered and authorized to execute leases for the exploration and production of same; and

WHEREAS, The said owners desire to institute suit against the State of Texas and the General Land Office to establish their ownership of coal and lignite under the above described property and their exclusive right to lease, sell, explore for, produce, or otherwise assert their ownership thereto; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of Texas, the House of Representatives concurring, That H. D. Schwarz, Jr., Louis C.






