for the New York & Texas Land Company.

Chas Howard ^{3rd} H. D. Franklin, Chain Carrier,

Beginning at the 51st mile post on
the 100th mer. N. L. the E. boundary line of
Wheeler County.

Thence N. (Var. $11^{\circ} 6' E$) at 1900 ft pass 20th N.
of the 59th mile post. at 1900 ft pass 32nd N.
of the 61st mile post. Thence E. 3/4 the 61st mile
post. Thence N. 1900 ft. the 62nd mile post.

The course between the 61st and 62nd mile posts
was ascertained to be at a var of $11^{\circ} 6' E$, by
placing a flag on both marks and placing the
compass upon an elevation south of the 61st
mile post, and on a line with both flags.

The course between the 51st and 59th mile was
found to be N. at a var. of $10^{\circ} 30'$ and the course
between the 59th and 62nd mile posts was
adopted (viz. $11^{\circ} 4' E$) to run West upon for
the reason that such course followed the 100th
mer. N. L. for ten miles in that locality.

In the line above described as having been run
N. from the 51st mile post, several survey marks
were passed to the East of the line but could
not be identified as marks of the Jones & Brown
survey, and in fact were not marks of such
survey and not noticed on this work.

Mr Onolundio stated to me when we commenced
the survey that he had run a line from the
51st mile post and missed the 61st mile post
13 1/2^{rs} running at a var. of $11^{\circ} 32' E$, and
then run S from the 61st mile at a var. of $11^{\circ} 30' E$

to the 51st mile post and then run N. from
the 61st mile post at said Var. of 11° 30' E.

This course would have missed the 51st mile
post about 170 rs. Hence the error of his survey.

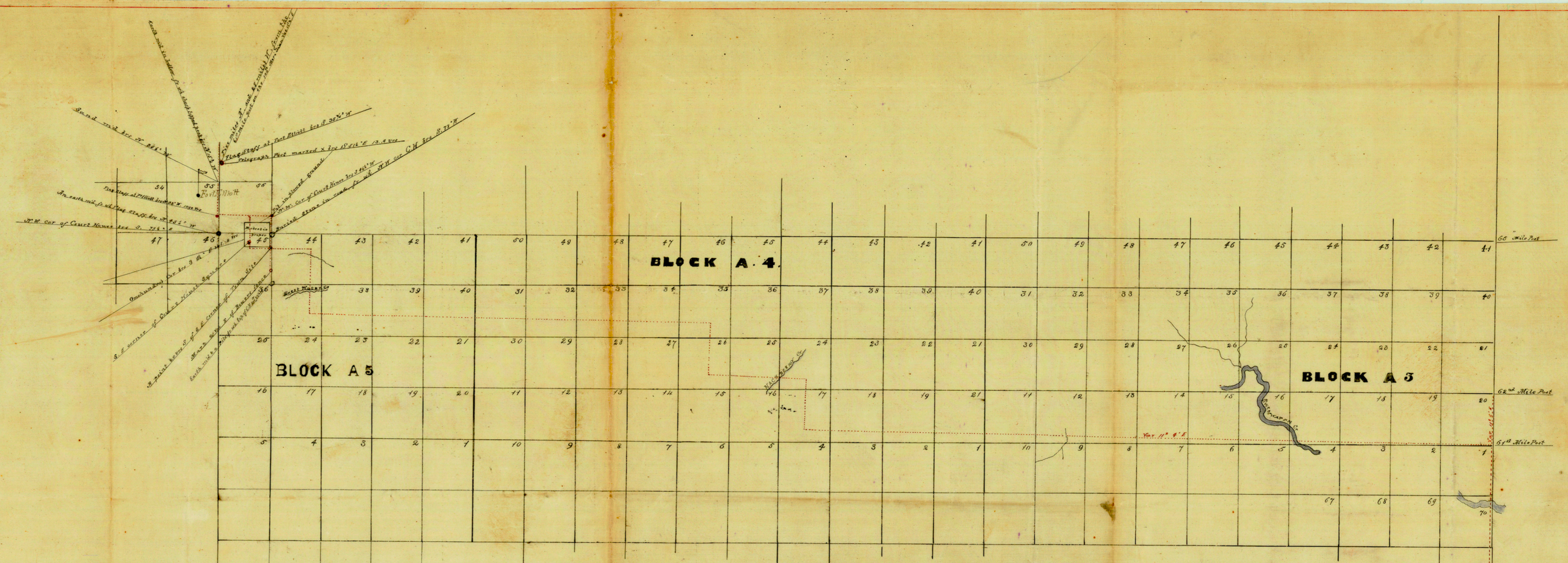
