Vernon Aug. 5th. 1885.

Surveyed for the Houston and Texas Central Rail Road Co. the following connecting line to establish the Va. and base lines of Block "A." in Hardeman County Texas.

Began at the S.E. corner No. 51. and N.E. corner of No. 50. Block 1 H. & T. C. R.R. Co. in Wilbarger County. Thence with a Va. of $89^{\circ}16' E$. ran S. $18^{\circ} E$. 1900 rs. to the S.E. corner of No. 50. same Block, Thence S. $72^{\circ} W$. 740 rs. to a point on the S.B. line of said section No. 50. in Block No. 1. Thence South 2245 rs. to a rock mound, from which a mesquite stump brs. N. $1^{\circ} W$. 39 rs. found the stone mound, and mesquite stump, marked \equiv as called for in the field notes it being the S.E. corner of the original Block A.

Began at this corner running with a Va. of $10^{\circ} E$. Thence West on the S.B. line of Block A. as originally located, on the third mile crossed a branch, the line passing through a grove, found where the undergrowth had been cut off of the line and a chittin tree marked \equiv fore and aft, on the line. At 7690 rs. found the large cotton wood tree marked \equiv as called for in the field notes, at 8240 rs. crossed Lower Beaver Creek, here I found a hacked line of old survey, exactly on my line, same course continued to 26600 rs. where notes called for S.E. corner of 2654. S.W. corner of 264, continued, same course to 27355 rs. and then ran N. $18^{\circ} W$. 78 rs. and found the original corner with the three mesquite bearings as called for in the original field notes. Found an excess of 755 rs. in running from the S.E. corner of the Block. (14 miles) up to this point. Thence ran from the S.E. corner of 265 Block A. N. $45^{\circ} W$. 2687 rs. to N.E. corner of 302 and N.W. corner # 265 here I put in a mesquite stake for corner, Thence North 1900 rs. a mesquite stake for N.E. corner of 301, North 1900 rs. a piece of stone for N.E. corner # 300 in south edge of Brakes, Thence North at 1900 rs. a mesquite stake for N.E. corner of # 299 on the south side of a prong of Beaver, thence North at 4000 rs. cross a pool of water on same prong of Beaver, at 19000 rs. put in stake for N.E. # 298. Thence North at 325 rs. pass a

dead mesquite stump, marked $\overline{\overline{X}}$ and 30 rs. West of my line
at 2127 rs found the original corner 10 rs. West of my line,
the N.E. corner of Sec. 277. Block A. Here I found the
hackberry bearings called for in the original filed notes.
