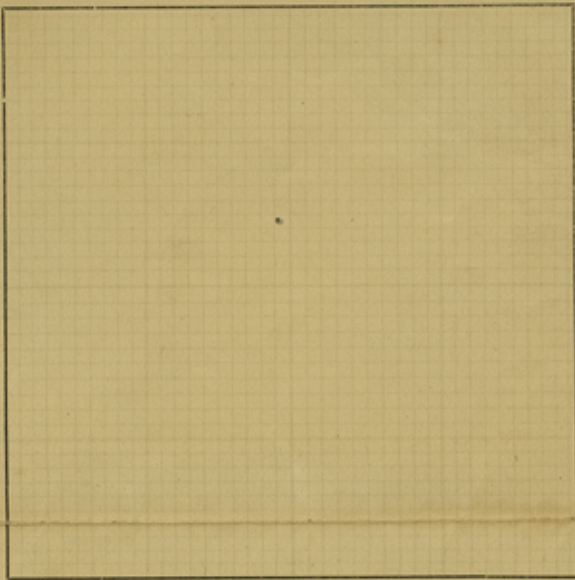

FIELD NOTES of a Survey of connecting line
between blocks 8, 9, & 14 Land, made for
H. & J. C. R. R. Co. in Wilbarger
County Texas.

Said Survey is No. in County, Texas, situated on the waters of
a tributary of River, about miles of
Beginning at W. E. cor. # 1, & W. W. Cor

#12. Block 9. a stake from which a cott. wood
ors. N. 71 E. 115' ors. Thence N. 3. 72 W. 1900' ors. the
N. W. corner of said sur # 1. Blk. 9. Thence S. 18 E. 400' ors.
a st. the N. E. corner of sur # 1. Blk. 8. Thence S. 18 E. 1900'
ors. the S. E. corner of #1. Blk. 8. Thence S. 72 W. along the
S. B. line of 1, 12, 13, 24, 25, & 36 at 11400' ors. the S. W. cor. #36
Thence N. 18 W. along an old hack line (cotton wood trees)
at 1840' ors. the south bank of Pease River, the corner being
54' ors in the bed of river. at this corner I tested the
course of the river and found on the W. B. line # 36. it
is N. 72 E. here it is plain to be seen that the bank of river
was marked away on south side. I also tested the course of
the river and found its general direction on the north
side of J. M. Dallas sur and sections 12, 13, & 24 to be
very close to what is called for in original surveys.
I then went back to N. E. corner of 1. Blk. 9. and then ran
S. 18 E. 1900' ors. to S. E. cor. 1. and S. W. cor. 12. Thence N. 72 E. 1900' ors.
to S. E. cor. #12. Thence S. 18 E. 9500' ors. to S. E. cor. 7. & S. W. cor
#18. Blk. 9. thence N. 72 E. along the S. B. line Blk. 9.
at 7100' ors. a point 500' ors. S. 72 W. from S. E. cor. # 31. Blk. 9.
Thence N. 7 1/4 W. 440' ors. Thence N. 11 1/4 W. 825' ors. to a stake the S. W.
corner of section 110 Block 14.
