same does not truthfully represent what they did
say on the subject, and was designedly and covertly
perverted for some sinister object.

Affiants further state that they have good
reason to believe and do believe that
Chas Wheeler was in Hardeman County on his
place, at the time of the above proceedings, and
that said Warren knew it.

Riddle J.P. of Precinct No 1 said County, do hereby certify that on last Saturday morning, Sept 18th, two men who called themselves Warren and Shriner respectively, came into my office and asked me to issue subpoenas for G. Mc Taylor, V. R. Faut, and others - That Warren said he was a lawyer and represented the said Shriner, and believing him to be such, and depending on his representations, I thought it was a part of my official duty to issue subpoenas for the witnesses designated and singled out by him - That after said witnesses were thus brought before me, said Warren conducted the examination and wrote out the certificates for them to sign - That said witnesses in their oral examination, stated that they could not swear positively as to the residence of Chas Wheeler, as he was in this town a good deal, and absent at other times, and did not know what particular place he claimed as his home - Affiant would further state that he does not know that said witnesses, after being orally questioned, paid particular attention to what was actually written down by said Warren - That at the time of said proceedings, Chas Wheeler was absent from this town, and affiant heard and believes that he was then in Hardeman County on his place, and that said Warren knew the fact, having seen and left him the preceding day - Affiant is reliably informed and believes that said Warren is no lawyer, but willfully represented himself to be one, in order to impose upon affiant and
