



I Thos. C. Thomson a deputy Surveyor of a Milan Land District do
 Certify that the foregoing Sketch is a true representation of
 the Surveys as I find them to be by actual Survey on
 the ground, I began at the N.E. corner of a Survey in the name
 of Thos. B. Shell from which an Elm tree bears N 27 1/2 E 10 varas
 marked V and another marked P bears N 6 1/2 W 16 varas
 thence N 71 1/2 E 863 varas crossed the N 71 W line of S. Millers Survey
 at 1340 varas enter timber but find no line marked
 1540 varas to the end established the S.E. corner
 there being none previously made that I could
 find. Thence N 19 W 810 varas dropped said millers
 line continued through timber and prairie 5420
 varas and there made the N.E. corner of said
 Goods Survey, this corner is in Brushy Creek Bottom
 but I did not find a corner made thence
 S 71 W 1540 varas to said Goods N.W. corner which
 is in prairie where I established a corner for good
 not finding one made and farther I did not find
 either lines or corners marked on the entire
 Survey except the Beginning corner or N.E. corner
 of said Shell I then returned to goods N.E. corner &
 6 varas and intersected League N 23 in the name of H
 White 125 varas S 71 W from its S.E. corner at which
 point I established the N.E. corner of a Survey
 made by me in the name of C. C. Browning
 at which point I could not find an old
 corner. I also run a line from said Shells N.E.
 corner as follows S 71 W 2220 varas a branch 3033 vs enter
 Bottom timber, but found no marks of an old line
 3240 enter prairie 4797 vs to a stake for the South
 West corner in the prairie thence N 19 W 1180 varas
 enter Bottom timber 1430 drop any fork of Brushy
 Creek 5360 vs second any fork of Brushy 5420 varas
 and established the N.W. corner in timber but

find no corner formerly made neither do I find
 any of the lines of this Survey marked except a
 short distance on the north line of Shells
 Survey running from his N.E. corner S 71 W, &c
 I also found the west or N.W. corner of J. F. Guthries
 Survey to conflict with Wilfred Cartwright as
 represented by the foregoing Sketch
