

James Crawford - Situated on the waters of  
Milbarger's Creek, situated about eight  
leguas north of the new Village of Gastrop  
bounded on the East by the title of land  
surveyed for Jesse Walker, according to  
the plan number 2, and from the S.E.  
corner of said title, commenced the survey  
and ran a line to the N.  $10^{\circ}$  E. follow-  
ing the Eastern line of the same title  
10,000 varas to the N.E. corner of the  
same title which also formed the N.W.  
corner of this title. Thence S.  $80^{\circ}$  E. 2500  
varas to a land mark for the N.E.  
corner. Thence S.  $10^{\circ}$  N. 10,000 varas and  
set a land mark for the S.E. corner.  
Thence N.  $80^{\circ}$  N. 2500 varas to the place  
of beginning -

Situated on the waters of Milbarger's  
Creek above the Great Road, and  
is No. 7 according to the plan of survey  
Commencing on a stake the S.W. corner  
of title No. 6, N.  $80^{\circ}$  N. 2500 varas set another  
stake for a corner. Thence N.  $10^{\circ}$  E. 3000  
varas to a creek and at 4000 varas set a  
stake for corner. Thence S.  $80^{\circ}$  E. 2500 varas  
set another stake for corner. Thence S.  $10^{\circ}$   
N. 10,000 varas to beginning -

Jacob Casner - Situated on the waters of Milbarger's  
Creek to the E of the Colorado river and  
between eleven and twelve titles north  
of the new Village of Gastrop and acc-  
ording to the plan No. 11, bounded on the  
N. by No. 9 surveyed for Rodgers,  
Commencing 1500 varas N. of the S.W.  
corner of No. 9, N.  $80^{\circ}$  N. 2500 varas -

and raised a mound of earth for a corner. Thence  $N. 10^{\circ} E. 10,000$  varas & raised another mound for a corner. Thence  $S. 80^{\circ} E. 2,500$  varas to another mound for a corner. Thence  $S. 10^{\circ} W. 10,000$  varas to the place of beginning. Situated to the E. of the Colorado river on the waters of Millbarger's Creek about 8 & 9 leagues North of the new Village of Matrop, bounded on the E. by the title surveyed for Willis Avery and to the West of the survey of James Crawford and commencing at the S.W. corner of the title of Crawford  $N. 80^{\circ} W. 2,500$  varas to the S.E. corner of said title of Avery. Thence  $N. 10^{\circ} E.$  and following the Eastern line of said title 10,000 varas to the N.E. corner of said title which is also the N.W. corner of this title. Thence  $S. 80^{\circ} E. 2,500$  varas to the S.W. corner of said title of Crawford which is also the N.E. corner of this survey. Thence  $S. 10^{\circ} W.$  and following the Western line of said title 10,000 varas to the beginning.

Willis Avery - Situated E. of the Colorado river on the waters of Millbarger's Creek about 8 & 9 leagues N. of the new Village of Matrop and according to the plan is No. 1, adjoining and to the E. of the land surveyed for Jacob Eckberg and to the West of that surveyed for Jesse Rankin and from the S.W. corner run a line  $N. 80^{\circ} W. 2,500$  varas to the S.E. corner of said Eckberg. Thence  $N. 10^{\circ} E.$  following the Eastern line of said land

10,000 varas to the N.E. corner of the same which also formed the N.W. corner of this survey. Thence  $S. 80^{\circ} E. 2,500$  varas to the S.W. corner of Rankin which formed the S.E. corner of this survey. Thence  $S. 10^{\circ} W.$  following the Western line of said title 10,000 varas to the beginning. Situated to the E. of the Colorado river, on the waters of Millbarger's Creek about 9 leagues North of the new Village of Matrop, commenced on a stake and marked the S.W. corner of the title of Willis Avery. Thence  $N. 80^{\circ} W. 2,500$  varas and set a stake in the prairie for the S.W. corner. Thence  $N. 10^{\circ} E. 10,000$  varas and set a stake in the prairie for the N.E. corner. Thence  $S. 80^{\circ} E. 2,500$  varas to the S.W. corner of said survey. Thence  $S. 10^{\circ} W. 10,000$  varas to the place of beginning.

Situated above the Major Road to the E. of the Colorado river, and commencing adjoining and to the N. of A.M. Childers and according to the plan No. 8, commencing at the upper S.W. corner of said title. Thence  $N. 80^{\circ} W. 2,500$  varas and set a stake for the S.W. corner. Thence  $N. 10^{\circ} E.$  another line 10,000 varas and set a stake for the N.E. corner. Thence  $S. 80^{\circ} E. 2,500$  varas and set a stake for the S.E. and series for the S.W. corner of Childers. Thence  $S. 10^{\circ} W.$  following the Western line of said title 10,000 varas to the beginning.
