Shell N^o. 170 for one League and one labor of land Issued by the board of Land Commissioners of Jasper County on the 23rd of March A.D. 1838. - Said survey is N^o in Williamson County, situated on the S. E. side of Brushy Creek about 25 miles S. 65° E. from the town of Georgetown. Beginning at the S. E. cor of the Williford Cartright leg

- Thence S. 71° W. 4067 v.s. to corner on said Cartright S. line, for N E cor of J. M. Leovey.
- Thence S. 19° E. 342 1/2 v.s. to cor in N. line of Willis West Survey
- Thence N. 66° E. (course calculated), in a direct line to the beginning 4089 v.s.

No 4 Williford Cartwright thence N 71° E with the S line to the place of beginning; this survey seems to conflict with the Willis West survey and according to the ruling of Judge E. B. Turner at the last term of our District Court, there is no vacancy, where one line calls for another and course and distance fails to reach the same.

Report of a Re-Survey of the west boundary line of the Willis West Survey and the east boundary line of the Hannible Good $\frac{1}{4}$ League survey, as follows, viz. - Beginning at a Stake previously set by me for the N. E. cor. of Hannible Good $\frac{1}{4}$ League. Thence S. $19^{\circ} E.$ at 4400 varas set a tem stake. I then went to the N. E. cor. of the Tho. S. Shell League and measured N. $19^{\circ} W.$ 1020 varas to a point in the west line of the H. Good Survey - Thence N. $71^{\circ} E.$ 1540 varas to a point in the S. line of the said Good Survey - Thence S. $19^{\circ} E.$ at 181 $\frac{1}{3}$ vs to a point opposite my tem. Stake, and 22 vs S. $71^{\circ} W.$ from it; at 212 varas set a Stake for intersection of H. Good S. line with the west boundary line of the Simon Miller League, from which an oak tree 12 in dia bears S. $20^{\circ} W.$ (new) 98 varas distant, and another oak tree 6 in. dia. bears S. $20^{\circ} W.$ 85 varas distant. This last was made the cor. in my former field notes. - Thence N. $20^{\circ} E.$ with the Miller line 179 varas and set a Stake from which an oak tree (P.O., 12 in dia bears N. $44^{\circ} W.$ $3\frac{1}{3}$ vs. distant and another Post Oak tree 18 in. dia. marked in the League Line (old mark), bears N. $20^{\circ} E.$ $13\frac{2}{3}$ vs distant. This is for the South cor. of the Willis West ^{or} and is 320 vs further S. $20^{\circ} W.$ than the field notes would place it; but is ruled to go to this place on account of calling for the N. W. cor. of the Phil. Prater Survey, but no bearing trees were found to said corner. Thence N. $19^{\circ} W.$ 5420 vs. to the N. W. cor. of the Willis West Survey ^{set a post} it is on the south side of a pond, and not correct, one tallied (The stake was set 170 vs too far south by a miscount of tallies) From the true cor. N. $19^{\circ} W.$ 415 vs further to the intersection of S. line of Williford Cartright League 13 vs N. $71^{\circ} E.$ from the S. W. cor. of same. I then went to the Stake which I had set for the N. E. cor. of the H. Good Survey and moved it for correction N. $19^{\circ} W.$ 176 vs and put a Stake & Stones for cor. which is S. $19^{\circ} E.$ 60 varas and Thence N. $71^{\circ} E.$ 20 vs from the S. E. cor. of the C. C. Browning Survey. - Over.

Leaving only a strip of 60 vs wide between the
Christopher C. Browning & the H. Good surveys instead of
236 varas ^{was believed to be, and} as set out in former field notes - This
correction should therefore be made upon the records
of said field notes, which error was made by a mis-
count of one tally in the first survey.
