Sir

Yours of the 15th ult. relative to a question of vacancy between the M. J. de la Garza (1-947) and the surveys lying westward, the Losoya, Parrott & Mumley, was received in due time but an answer was deferred supposing that I would see Mr Mc Donough the owner of the D. L. Kokernot certificate.

I have not seen him but send you a rough draft of results of surveys made by me of lands connected with that in question. The Call in the Losoya field note for the N.W. corner of No. 118 (Garza) would show that no vacancy could exist between the lines of the two surveys, yet an actual survey shows two lines about 140 vara apart, however I would not have made the survey had not the Land office previously recognized a vacancy.

In surveying in this portion of the county I find
many great discrepancies ~~over~~ originations which suppose
in carelessly connecting different systems of survey.
