Macaya docket hereby certify that there is no record
in this office of any field notes in the following
names to wit,

The above names were placed upon the map
without reference to the Records; they were simply
transcribed from an old plot of a block survey
made by Jacob Snively which has been in the
office for many years and the names upon
it appear to be in the handwriting of said
Snively.

I do further certify that the survey of Mesa
in name of Matias Bodain is represented in the
wrong place. it should be East and adjoining
the survey of Wm Barnhill. The Records of
this office do not show that there is any survey
which would occupy the place of M Bodain
when its place is changed to the survey of its
present position on the map.

I also certify in addition to the above that the
surveys in the name of D. Cherry and D. Cren-
shaw are on Record. but the field notes of the survey
of D. Crenshaw are entirely without the proof
required by law and without the application
of any certificates. The claim of D. Cherry
as I have been informed (and which ^{I presume} the Act
of the Genl Land will show) has been removed
from its first locality and patented in another

place.
