In answer to your inquiry for data concerning surveys Nos. 435, and 615 in Zapata County near the Pedernal grant, I am herein enclosing a blue print showing what our survey of the partition of this grant showed.

We had a double set of chain carriers and checked with the Blucher and the Monroe survey all along, except along the south line of the Pedernal where we found our line to be 25 varas shorter than what Mr. Blucher had made it.

We also closed on the Porciones and corrected some surveys on the ground for Mr. T.C. Mann an Atty. of this city and also for M.A. Hirsch who owns some tracts northwest of the Pedernal grant.

The original stones and corners to these surveys were on the ground and they differ considerably from their calls in the field notes.

Hoping that this blue print will be of some service to your office
