Dear Sir;

The following shows work done by me on the ground and condition of surveys in Zapata, County, being lands owned by the Est. of Francisco Garcia Martinez.

Survey No. 2 T. & N. O. Ry.

This survey was begun at a stone at old fence cor with bearing trees called for in orig F. Notes and is the recognized cor of this survey.

At its NE cor I found a stk and stone Md at fence cor on E line of sur 1. From this point fence runs to a stone & orig brg tree at fence cor and is recognized as NW cor of sur. 1.

At its SE cor I found a post & pile of rocks the recognized cor of this and surrounding surveys.

At its SW corner I found a stone on fence the dividing line of surveys 2 & 119

Survey No. 4 H. & G. N. Ry

This survey was begun at a stone on old fence being the recognized SW cor of survey 2 & NW cor hereof.

At its NE cor I found a post & pile of rocks the recognized cor of this and of surrounding surveys.

At its SE cor I found a stone on fence. This being recognized as the cor of this and surrounding surveys.

The SW cor of this is a stk at old fence corner.

Survey No. 624 E. Squier Ry

This survey was begun at a stk that Bfs 272 vs N35W from the E cor of the Cerrito Blanco grant, as called for in orig F. Nts of surveys 6 & 624

From this point I ran to a stone at fence cor the recognized SE cor of sur 6 and continued to NW cor of sur 86 NE cor hereof.

Running south from this point along old sendero I set a stk on old fence recognized as N line ~~line~~ of sur 85 at SW cor of sur 86. From this point I ran the distance called for in orig F. Notes to establish NW cor of sur 85.

From NW cor Of 85 I ran south to an old fence which has always been recognized as the dividing line of sur 161-85 & 624. From this point I followed the Old fence to the beginning.



Survey No. 6 T & N. 0 Ry.

This survey was begun at a stk that bears N. 35 W 272 vs from a stone the recognized cor of the cerrito Blanco grant.

From this point, running on an easterly course I found a stone at old fence corner being the recognized SW cor of survey 5 SE corner hereof.

Running north I found a stone on fence NE corner hereof and of surrounding surveys.

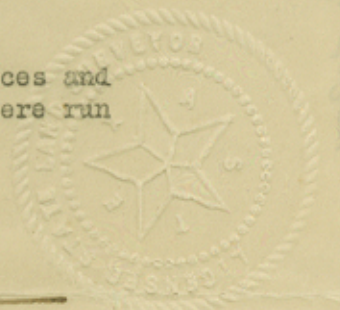
At its NW corner I found a stake at an old fence corner and continued down fence line to the begining.

Most of the fences mentioned above, judging from distances and courses given in orig F. Notes, were built on the lines that were run by the surveyors that made the original surveys.
