the ground with two sworn Chain men  
J. W. Fisher and N. Tibbs and began at the  
upper corner of Jus Wilkinson Sur. No 10.  
in Zavalla Co. on November 6<sup>th</sup> 1882. at a  
stake set on the north bank of Leon river  
a L.O. bro. S 75 N. 4. 700. (an Elm stump  
body of Iron ground) bro. S 72 E 6 700.

I then ran N 15 E. at 5559 700. set a  
stake for the N.E. corner of C. P. Thompson  
Sur. No 11. a Mex. 15" bro. S 16 1/2 E. 21 700. a Do.  
14" bro. S 50 E. 16 1/2 700. at 9055 700. set a

stake for the N.W. corner of said Wilkinson  
Sur. No 10. a Mex 10" bro. S 75 1/4 E. 52 700.

Thence S 75 E. 2050 700 to a stake set in a  
swag for the N.E. of said Wilkinson, Sur.  
Thence N 15 E. 16 700. to a stake. the N.W.  
corner of M. E. Diaz Sur. No 9.

Thence S 75 E. 2050 700. crossing the  
old Presidio road to a stake the N.E.  
corner of said Diaz Sur. No 9. a Mex.  
10" bro. West 7 700. "Mex" 8"

Thence N 15 E. recrossing said old road
