

Connecting line from the SW corner  
of the John Wilkinson League survey #10  
to the S.E. corner of J. H. Estey League  
No 22

Beginning at the SW corner of said  
Wilkinson League state on the bank of the Leona  
from which a live oak marked  $\odot$  was S 25 W  
4 varas. The roots of Elm are all that remains  
Thence S 71 W 42 varas S 35 W 67 varas  
S 67 W 52 varas N 76 W 200 - N 15 E 281  
varas - N 75 W 600 - S 15 W 30 varas  
N 75 W 1750 - S 15 W 40 varas - N 75 W 58  
S 15 W 80 - N 75 W 617 - S 15 W 20 - N 15 E 410  
N 75 W 950 - S 15 W 1000 - N 75 W 1600  
intersected the west line of Thos Thompson  
Thence S 15 W 2950 with an old blazed  
line through bottom to a stake on N.E. bank  
of Leona River from which a piece 12  
inches in dia mtd  $\odot$  was S 11 W 10 varas  
no sign of oak left. SW cor of T Thompson  
# 13 Thence N 15 E  
(or back with line 2950) to where first  
intersected it Thence N 25 W 1600  
into Leona River bottom N 65 E 360  
N 25 W 392 - N 65 E 463 - N 25 W 2517  
S 65 W 2400 (Leona River at 6250) (but I  
came back on line so as to pass a dead)  
N 25 W 2580 intersected the S.E. line of Estey  
League No 22 Thence S 65 W 3940 to S.E.  
corner of said survey fully identified on the  
ground by the bearing N 85 E viz L. O. S 18 E  
2 varas L. O. N 3 E 4 varas marked  $\odot$
