to N W cor N 73 W to N W cor #17 and S 15 W to S W cor
#17 N 64 to the S W cor #9 as claimed by you but
at the S W cor #17 he stopped and when he ran from the
S W cor #20 Hooper had he failed to find the S W cor

* 97 Hooper & made and farther and he set a stake for the S.E. Cor # 11 a B.M. containing an L set a cor for S.E. Cor # 10 S.W. Cor # from this point he ran S 15 W 3 miles marking corners he never used in his field notes but which can now be identified on the ground. This plainly shows you that he never connected his lower and upper work together and there are no connecting corners between 9 & 10 there is no reason why either survey can run other wise than course and distance # 9 is bound to hold to S.W. Cor # 13 while # 10 is bound to hold to S.W. Cor # 11. I am fully aware of the fact that # 9 & 10 should hold together there is no law whereby you can cause a mapped survey to run other than course & distance where the points called for are unmarked. Referring again to S.E. Cor # 11 you can not move it from the point Mr H marked for it to the point he failed to find
