I hereby certify that, in the spring of 1885, I draw a line of connection due South from the S.E. corner of New Mexico into Pecos County - crossing the Pecos River a little West of the Ripples. - I further certify that I identified the S.E. cor. of New Mexico (an earth or sand mound with an old pine stake marked "N. M. 1859") by its position with reference to earth mounds North of it on the East line of New Mexico; also by its position with reference to earth mounds West of it on the South Boundary line of New Mexico; also by the situation of the drain or draw North of it, and now known as Monument Springs Draw - as described in the report of the U.S. Boundary Commission, and by other marks and objects. -

I further certify that my line of connection ran due South from said S.E. corner of New Mexico, 80 miles, and that said line passed West of Block "O.W" Dummys 1 to 106 inclusive, and closed at a point on the North line of the 80 mile Reservation of the Texas and Pacific Resem. -

3 having been abandoned - makes existing Durall
1900' farther South - or a total of 12.787 varas S.
