Be it remembered that on the 13th day of October A.D. 1930, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in regular Monthly Session, the following members and officers and Present and presiding, to-wit: Honorable R.W. Pittmen, County Judge, J.I. McCullough, Commissioner Precinct No. 1; J.W. Childers, Commissioner Precinct No. 2; C.E. Rollins, Commissioner Precinct No. 3; R.M.E. Hughes, Commissioner Precinct No. 4; J.N. McCleskey, Sheriff, and Carroll Cobb, Clerk.

The Court being opened by the Sheriff according to law the following buisness was had and the following orders passed and approved, to-wit:

On this day came on for consideration of the Court the Surveying of the County Line between Gaines and Andrews Counties and it is ordered by the Court that said Line be Surveyed and Established, also that the North-east and North-west corners be established. It is ordered by the Court that Robert E. Estes a Licensed State Surveyor be employed to represent Gaines County, and to make said Survey, at a cost of \$900.00, \$300.00, cash, and \$300.00 to be paid by Warrant dated 1931 and \$300.00 to be paid by Warrant dated 1932.
