To the Honorable County Court  
of Anderson County pursuant to an order issued  
to me from said Court paper at the July  
Term 1848 and said order having been amended  
at the August Term 1848 of said Court appointing  
me to run the Northern boundary line of said  
County of Anderson I went to the place of  
beginning (at the N. E. Corner of John Ferguson's  
League) On the 15<sup>th</sup> day of September the day  
named in said order and not having been  
met by a surveyor from Anderson County  
or Tangah County I proceeded to run and  
mark said line

Beginning at the above named  
North East Corner of John Ferguson's League  
on the West Bank of the Cheches River corner  
on an Iron Wood or a horn Beavers 1 inches in diam  
the marked A.C. Thence S.  $80^{\circ}50'$  West at 9 miles  
Crosses Caddo Creek 20 miles 1140 Varas to the East  
Boundary line of Anderson County at 25  
miles 373 Varas Crosses Cat fish Bayou  
thirty six (36) miles 884 Varas to the East Bank  
of the Trinity River a Hackberry for corner  
13 inches in diameter (marked A.C.L. 36 1/2 M from  
which an ash 20 in diameter marked A.C.  
bears South  $89^{\circ}E$  7 1/2 Varas distant an another  
ash 36 in di marked A.C. bears S  $41^{\circ}E$  10 1/2  
Varas distant said corner (the Northwest Corner  
of Anderson County) is about 3 miles 150 Varas  
North  $52^{\circ}$  West of the Northwest Corner of  
R W Botz assignee of James Wilson Survey  
of 2 1/3 two thirds of a League and one Labor  
of Land
