Filed 1<sup>st</sup> January 1848

To The Honorable County Court of Houston County  
pursuant to an order issued to me from said  
Court passed at the October term 1847  
appointing me to run the Northern  
boundary line of the said County of Houston  
I went to the place of beginning (Houston's mound)  
On the first Monday in December the day named  
in the aforesaid order and not having been  
met by any surveyor from Anderson County  
I proceeded to run and mark said line  
Beginning on the top of said mound (about  
three miles northwardly from the Residence of  
Martin Murchison) planted a Rock for Beginning  
marked H.C. Thence South  $80^{\circ}50'$  West at 10 miles  
120 Varas crossed the North branch of Elk hart  
Creek passing through the Old Tomie Village  
and said Creek at 19 miles 1810 Varas to the East  
Bank of the same I set an ash for corner marked  
H.C. L. M. from which an ash marked H.C.  
bears  $N 63^{\circ} E$  9 Varas distant and an ash marked  
XX bears  $S 77^{\circ} E$  4 Varas distant The line is  
plainly blazed and each mile tree or stake  
is marked with the letters H.C.L. and numbered  
from 1 to 20 Westwardly then beginning again  
at Houston's mound and run  $N 80^{\circ}50'$   
 $E$  at 1 mile 1360 Varas crossed Murchison's mile  
Creek at 8 miles 540 Varas the West bank of  
the Ochees River the corner there marked  
H.C.L. 8. the line from Houston's mound  
to the Ochees River is plainly blazed and  
each mile tree is marked H.C.L. and numbered  
from 1 to eight Eastwardly the distance  
from Rock to River is twenty eight miles  
and fifty varas
