Atascosa County. Field Notes of a survey made to establish the South line of Atascosa County and North line of M<sup>c</sup>. Mullen County, by virtue of an order of the Hon. Commissioners Court of Atascosa County, dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of February 1894.

Beginning at the S.W. corner of Atascosa County, being N.W. corner of M<sup>c</sup>. Mullen County a squared Mesquite Post on East side of Pearsall and Tilden road, marked Cor. on the South A on the East E, on the West and X X X on the North, and surrounded by pile of rock. Thence East over a Brushy ridge at 480 vs. going down into a prickly pear valley, at 1460 vs. passing North of a Coma Mott, on the Brink of a Black Chapparel ridge, at 1900 vs. the First mile Post, on top of said ridge, marked A on North M, on South and I, on West face, surrounded by pile of small stones.

Thence over said Black ridge and down in an open Valley crossing a draw of Livingston Creek at 1900 vs. the 2<sup>nd</sup> mile Post, between two prongs of said Livingston draw, marked A, on North M, on South and II, on West.

Thence East at 455 vs. crossing the North Easton draw before going up another Black Chapparel Hill at 817<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> vs. Granden Patino's house B.S. N. 16<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>° E., at 1125<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> vs. said House B.S. N 8<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>° E, (Thence North 1506 vs. and East 279<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> vs. intersect N.E. corner of survey N<sup>o</sup>. 1808 Geo. B. Robbins, rock pile for cor, at 335 vs Granden Patino's S.W. corner.) at 1900 varas the 3<sup>rd</sup> mile Post in open Prickly Pear Flat, marked A on the North M, on the South and III, on the West and surrounded by pile of stones.

Thence East, at 1415 vs. crossing Bear Branch between two large Mesquite trees marked ≡, at 1625 vs. crossing small (dry) Pond near a 5 pronged Mesquite marked ≡ at 1777 crossing R.C. Hollands

The mile posts unless otherwise described are  
Mesquite Posts, squared and pointed, thus and  
average about 10 inches in diameter.

This survey was made in March from 6<sup>th</sup> to  
17<sup>th</sup> days, inclusive except Sunday.

30 mile Posts, on the West line of Atascosa County,  
trees near the line marked ≡.

 Thence East at 1022 vrs, a white house supposed to be the Old Hall ranch Brs, N. 14<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>° W, Browns Ranch in Atascosa County Brs, N. 11° W, R. H. Browns Ranch Brs, S. 68° E, at 1900 vrs. 22<sup>nd</sup> mile Post marked A on the North M on the South and XXII, on the West.  
 Thence East at 1876 vrs, R. H. Browns house Brs, S. 29° W, at 1900 vrs. The 23<sup>rd</sup> mile, a rock for Post marked A on the North M on the South and XXIII, on the West, and also marked on East, Co. Line, Daughtery's ranch Brs N. 71° E.

Thence East at 817 vrs. Daughtery's ranch Brs, N. 69<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>° E. Basin Hill Brs, N. 31<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>° E, at 1900 vrs. The 24<sup>th</sup> mile Post, a rock marked A on the North M, on the South and XXIV, on the West, (Begin at South corner of sec. N. 23, J. Poirerick, a large tank about 200 vrs. - Thence S. 40° E, 1452 vrs. intersect Co. Line 1070 vrs. East of the 24<sup>th</sup> mile Post.)

N. 67<sup>o</sup> E. at 440 vs. a rock pile on Suggenbain Road, at 548 vs. crossing a hollow at 1212 vs. Austin & Williams #952 West line (fence) at 1629 vs. C.T. Hinder's house Brs.
