

AUSTIN COUNTY BOUNDARY LINE

Beginning at the mouth of Caney creek on the western side of the Brazos River; thence up the meanders of said creek to Mrs. Foster's crossing of the same; thence up the longest source of said creek to Andy Miller's crossing; thence to the junction of the southwestern source; thence to the southwest corner of Harmon Hensley's league of land, so as to include Stephen Williams and Robert Armstead in the county of Washington, to a league of land granted to David Shelby; thence in a direct line to a league of land granted to Samuel G. Pettus, including said land; thence in a direct line to the head of San Bernard, and down the same to the lower corner of Gabriel Cole's land (see act of March 24, 1846), it being part of a league originally granted to Charles Baird; thence along the lower line of said land to its southeast corner; thence in a direct line to the source of Sixteenth Mile creek; thence down said creek to its mouth; thence up Brazos river, with its meanders, to the place of beginning; Act May 3, 1838; 2 Cong. p.2; Mar. 24, 1846; 1 Leg, p.15; April 28, 1873; 13 Leg.; P.D.278.
