State of Texas } and Travis County from the
West Corner of the Solomon Duty $\frac{1}{4}$ league on
the north bank of the Colorado River to the
N. W. corner of the Isaac Casner, same being the
north corner of Bastrop County.

Beginning on the north bank of said river at
the west corner or same of the Solomon Duty $\frac{1}{4}$
league,

Thence $N27^{\circ}45'E$ (at a variation of $9^{\circ}31'E$)
at 5338 was passed the N. W. cor of said S. Duty. 5602, 242
was, continuing at 11600 was Millinger Creek and
at 12380 was crossed north line of the B. Osborne league
- at 563 was 5602, from the N. W. cor of same, continue
ing at 13300 was the Seventh Mile Post, there found
a deviation in bearing of the line of 30' eastward,
changed bearing to $N28^{\circ}15'E$ and continuing at 16925 was
crossed the north line of the Jacob Standifer $\frac{1}{2}$ league,
^{526 was 5602 from the N. W. cor of same}
continuing at 2147 was crossed the north line of the
^{245 was 5602 from the N. W. cor of same.}
Elizabeth Standifer league, and at 22670 was the north
line of the Johnathan Burleson $\frac{1}{4}$ league, 248 was 5602
from the N. W. cor of same, and at 26670 was. crossed
the north line of the Tho^s Christian league, 126 was
5602, from N. W. cor of same, and thence continuing
to 30670 was the N. W. cor of the Isaac Casner league
for the north cor of Bastrop County

The above line was planted at every mile a good
Cedar Post, lettered with the No^s of miles on each,
reckoning from the Colorado River
