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Honorable Commissioners Court
of Travis County:

In accordance with an order of
your Honorable Court, bearing date
— day of — 1885, I proceeded to the
point designated in said order to
run the line between the Counties
of Bastrop ^{and} Travis on south side
of Colorado River.

The Surveyor from Bastrop failing
to meet me I proceeded to run
same alone ^{and} the following is
my report:

Beginning at a point as near as
I could ascertain the same where
lower cor. of the M. Duty sur. was
made, originally being on north
bank of Colorado River, now about
2000 ft from the S margin of said
river at low water mark, thence
S. 45° W. 10200 ft cross line between
Robt. Hill and Dr. Calman 9950 ft.
S. 30° W. from corner of same 19000 ft
set cedar post in said Hill's
bottom field. 1st mile post.

1st mile post: 3640 ft Dry Creek
runs N. E 3800 ft set cedar post
in said Hill's field 2nd mile post.

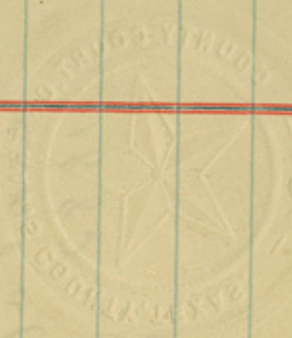
