

Beginning at a slab rock 18 x 24 inches set in  
ground on South side of small drain, course north west,  
said rock is facing to South East & stands West and  
marked as follows, viz: On N.W. Side  $\frac{5}{8}^{W.C.}$  and  
on S.E. Side  $\frac{B}{N.W.C.}^{S.O.A.}$  I sat up a second stone facing  
to SW marked  $\frac{N.E.}{B.C.XXX}$  and a third stone marked  
SEWC. This corner we identified as the N.W.  
corner of Archer County by the foregoing described  
first stone and by milestones North, South,  
East and West, whence also a dead double  
mes. tree was marked X brs. S.  $27\frac{1}{2}$  W 138 $\frac{1}{2}$   
vrs. another dead mesq. 8 in. in diameter marked  
X brs. S.  $35^{\circ} 50'$  W 118 vrs. Head of hollow in draw  
course N.W. brs. N. 100 vrs. and red bank at head  
of draw brs. S.  $87\frac{1}{2}$  E. 155 vrs. and Cottonwood on  
branch a little West of South (over hill) about  
700 vrs. and the N.W. corner of Survey No. 6 Block  
No. 6 H & T C. R. R. Co. brs. W. 516 vrs. and N. 76  
vrs.

Hence West at 230 vrs. edge of braky land course ct. at 920 vrs. cross branch in Valley at 1600 vrs. West edge of brash at 1900 $\frac{1}{2}$  vrs. a pile of flat sand stone rocks, one of which is marked  $\frac{B}{24}M$  and one marked, W 24 M in East edge of braky land leading North to Beaver Creek, whence top of draw mes. Stump

N. 436 vrs. and W. 222 vrs.

14<sup>th</sup> Mile

Turn West crossing heads of six draws in 500 vrs. at 1200 vrs. in canyon general course West at 1400 vrs. branch Course South west at 1500 vrs. mouth of branch at 1900<sup>8</sup> vrs. a stone in marked  $\frac{B}{M}$  on South Side and  $\frac{W}{M}$  on North Side whence a huckleberry marked X. hrs. S. 89<sup>1</sup>/4 East about 60 vrs. and a red bluff hrs. East 420 and S.W. corner of Survey No. 3 Block 3 hrs. S. 13<sup>1</sup>/4 vrs. and W. 150 vrs.

Side and W. 15 M. on North Side whence a huckleberry tree 4 m. in dia hrs. N. 30<sup>1</sup>/4 E. 20 vrs. marked X and huckleberry 6 m. in dia. marked X hrs. S. 59 E. 38 and N.E. corner of Survey etc. 81 Block 2 hrs. S. 70<sup>1</sup>/4 vrs. and E. 88 vrs.

E. at 1415 vs. crop bend in same North of line at 1900  $\frac{1}{2}$  vs. a stone on ridge marked  $\frac{B}{4} \frac{C}{M}$  on South Side and  $\frac{W}{4} \frac{m}{m}$  on North Side, whence N. W. Cor. etc. 17 Block 6 vs. S. 518 vs. and W. 898 vs.

### 5<sup>th</sup> Mile

Turn West at 115 vs. crop new road course S. W. at 1900  $\frac{1}{2}$  vs. a stone in Valley of branch marked  $\frac{B}{5} \frac{C}{M}$  on South Side and  $\frac{W}{5} \frac{m}{m}$  on North Side a mesq. tree marked X vs. N.  $5 \frac{1}{2}$  W. 4 vs. and another forked mesq. marked X vs. N.  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  W. 5 vs.

### 6<sup>th</sup> Mile

Turn West at 120 vs. a branch course N. 15 E. at 1900  $\frac{1}{2}$  vs. a stone marked  $\frac{B}{6} \frac{C}{M}$  on South Side and  $\frac{W}{6} \frac{m}{m}$  on North Side.

### 7<sup>th</sup> Mile

Turn West at 1344 vs. a pt. whence a Stake for N. W. Cor. Survey No. 4 Block 6 for H. & T. C. R. R. Co. vs. North 188 vs. at 1758 vs. enter branch general course S. E. at 1785 vs. out of same at 1900  $\frac{1}{2}$  vs. a stone marked  $\frac{B}{7} \frac{C}{M}$  on South Side and  $\frac{W}{7} \frac{m}{m}$  on E. Side whence N. W. Cor. said etc. 4 vs. E. 556  $\frac{1}{2}$  vs. and North 188 vs.
