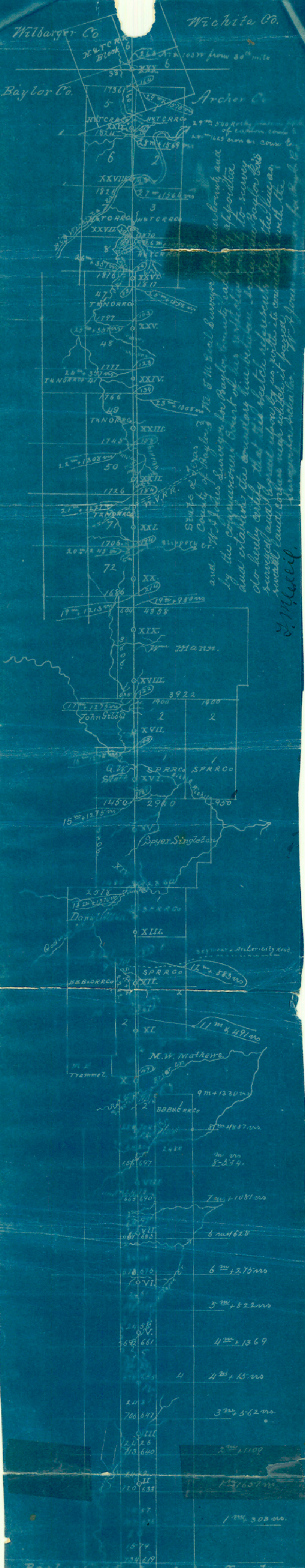

corner of Young county, a large stone
in a pile of rock marked A. B. S. by
about 930 varas east of Spring Creek
503 varas North of the South line
615 varas West of the East line 850
varas South of the North line and
738 varas E. of the West line of 1/2 Sec-
tion No. 15-78, for T. E. & L. Co. a stump
of a forked mesquite tree S. 8 1/2 E. 12
varas, another mesquite stump
br. N. 5-2° E. 33 varas, another br. S.
31° E. 125 varas, and a P. O. tree stand-
ing on rocky bluff bears S. 43 1/2 E.
about 800 varas.
