In regard to some field notes I recently sent you pertaining to those blocks (or surveys) of Tex Em & Ld Cos lands crossed by County I might have added that this survey was made in accordance with a letter from the County Judge Harold T. Dycus. The fact as County Surveyor at one time of Archer County Judge Dycus had sufficient knowledge of conditions there as to see the necessity of a proper apportionment of those lands especially to his own County.

I am certain you cannot find any material error in this apportionment. I have a copy of the letter I sent you, which I will forward to Archer County on your approval so as I see it, there is no need to do otherwise than to approve my field notes, and if found correct, to correct the several obstacles to the several surveys. The little fee coming to me is dependent upon your approval, a practice I have long adhered to.
