I, A.D. Kerr, do hereby certify that the accompanying sketch of lands in Baylor and Archer Cos. shows correctly the surveys platted thereon and shows the original corners, lines, distances, that especially by actually survey I found, by survey of South line of Baylor Co. that each of surveys 1578, 1575 and 1279 were 1353 vrs. long east and west. That by a line surveyed from the original S.E. corner of Survey No. 1578, Thence North at 2700 vrs. I identified the N.W. corner of 1581 and N. E. corner of Survey No. 1579, Also N.E. corner said 1581. At 5400 vrs. passed 1353 vrs. east of the original common corner of surveys 2412, 2413, 2426 & 2427 at 6750 vrs. found many trees of the kind called for but none marked ( all young) at 8100 vrs. to a stone set for N.E. corner of 2431, which we placed at 1353 vrs. East of its N.W. corner it being 633 vrs. west and 10 vrs. South of Mile stone No. 4. at 9450 vrs. at N. E. corner 2451, set from its orig. N. W. corner, evidenced by stump of the bearing tree. Mr. Dycus and I afterwards identified the N. E. corner of 2468 by stumps of bearings and by distance to creek 308 vrs. South called for in that survey from which a North & South fence bore West 90 vrs. I positively identified the S.W. corner of 2481 and a tree brs South easterly about 18 vrs. at N.W. corner 2481. I found or rather give to surveys 2481, 2478 & 2471 1358 vrs. each, but in the total line they average 1354 on their several east lines and 1352 on their West lines by which I think Messrs. Jones & Cecil were correct in estimating the average to be 1353 vrs. N. & S.

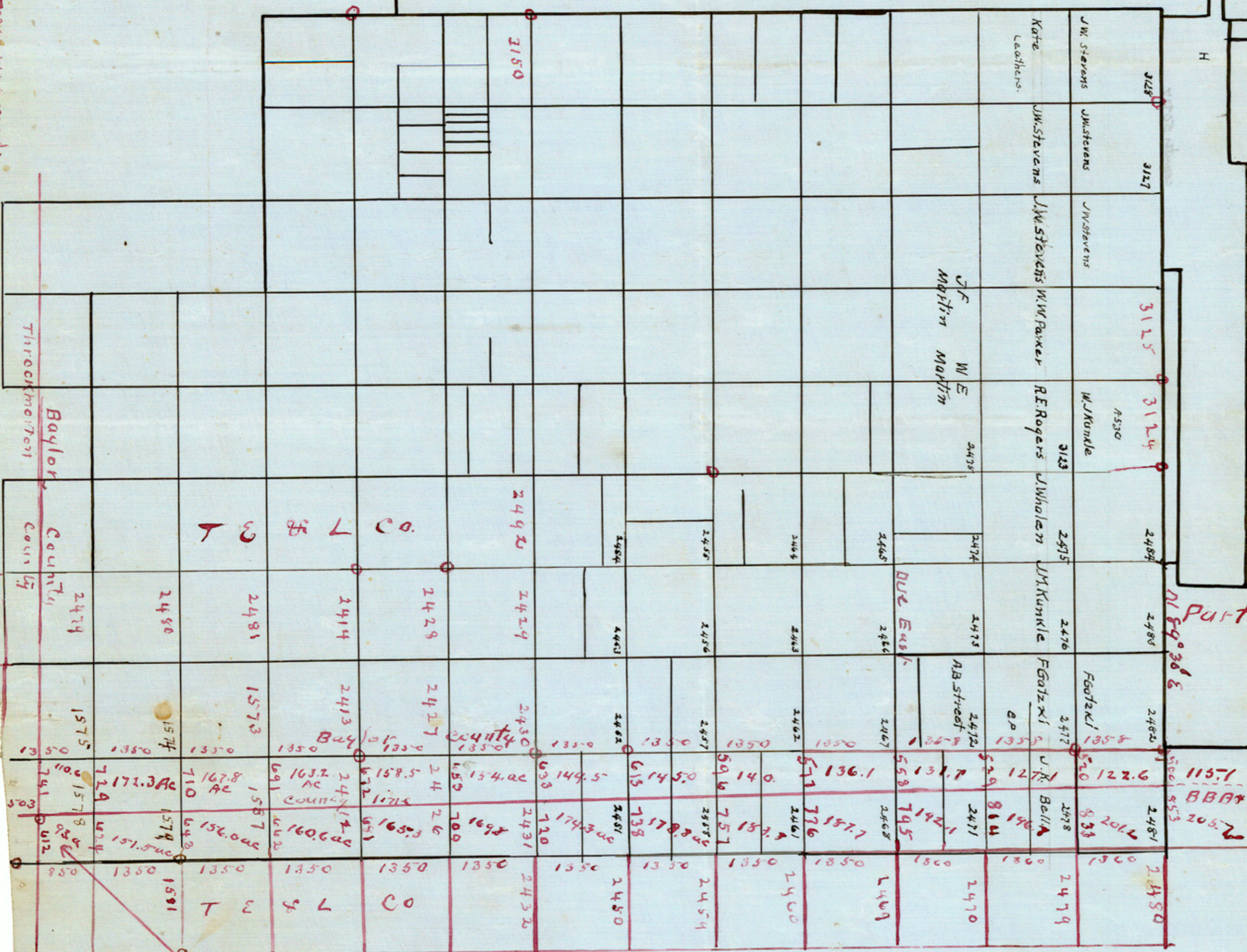

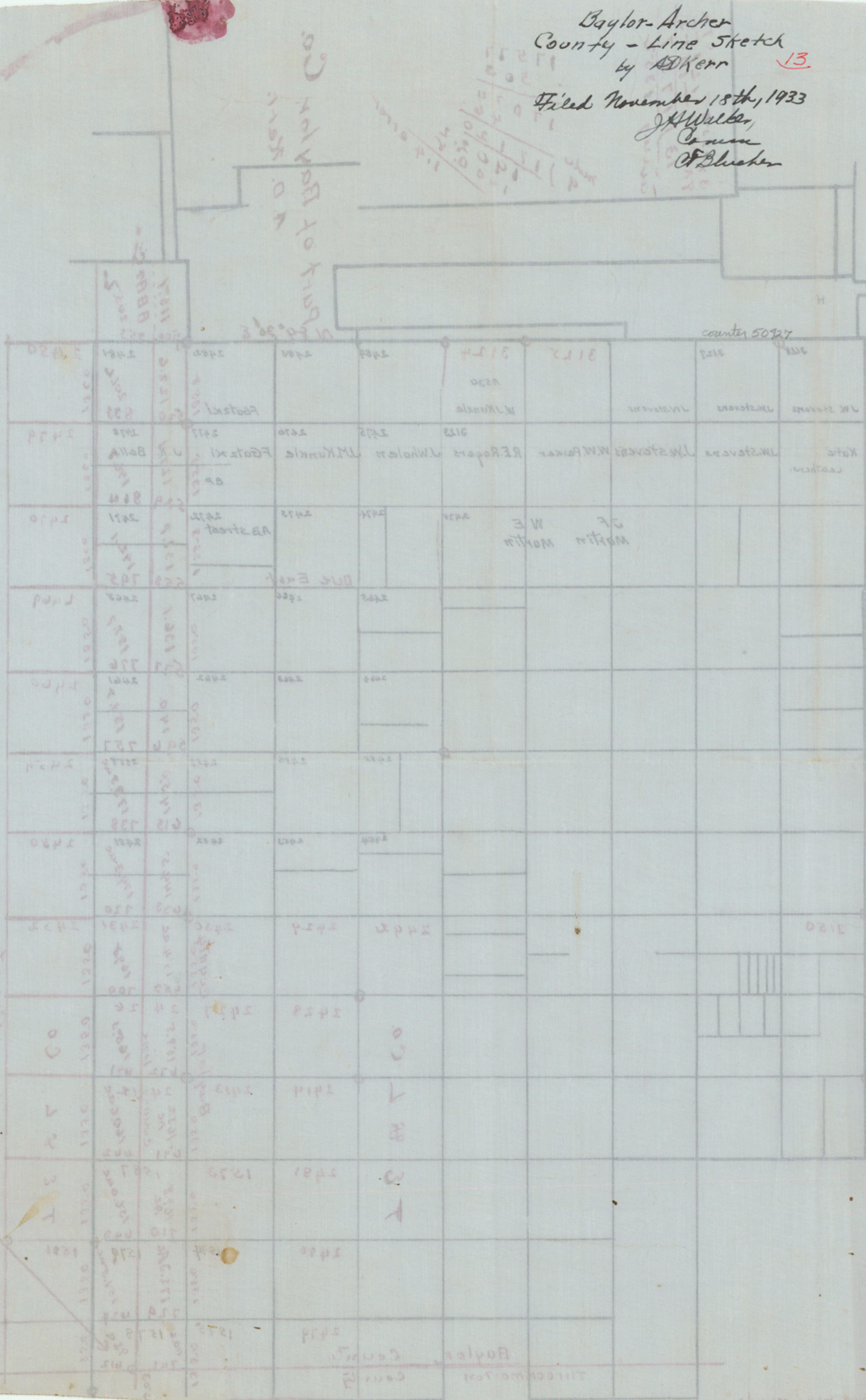
