Replying to your favor of 14<sup>th</sup> inst  
requiring more definite information to show in  
what way I identified this County Line.

Beq leave first of all that the County Line was legally  
and properly run by Messrs W.A. Jones and J.M. Cecil  
as far as course of the line is concerned, in 1894

But to give you one instance of a small error  
at the 4<sup>th</sup> mile stone which by the ~~first~~ connecting line  
inclosed we found 4<sup>th</sup> mile stone 10 rrs north

instead of 15 rrs south of north line of 2431 and the corner  
at both NE + NW corners were established by a joint  
survey by <sup>Jones</sup> him and me, and I for the purpose of this

survey found over N. line of 2431 - as stated in connecting line  
~~was~~ 633 rrs E of NW corner and 720 rrs W of <sup>its</sup> NE corner  
as we together made ~~it~~ <sup>these corners</sup>. But as I understand the

proposition, it is a question of the East and West  
lines of surveys 1578 to 2481 with reference to County line.

In other words I am not surveying, or making a  
County line, but to find out how many acres  
in each of those surveys lie in Archer Co and  
how many acres in Baylor. Of course I could

this way is the rational way. At any Rate

Mr Sayers Archer County is not getting his  
Share of Taxes. Too much land (214 acres)  
are Rendered in Baylor Co to 107 acres in Archer.  
This  $\frac{1}{3}$  in Archer and  $\frac{2}{3}$  in Baylor is <sup>due</sup> an estimate  
it appears long before any of these Counties were  
organized. I am Surveyor of Baylor County  
but I will do honest work for any County  
or individual or Corporate body, I head to the  
line and let the chips fall where they will.  
These field notes, sketch and data are ~~an~~ evidence  
of the Correctness of my work.

you are Laboring under one error to wit  
The Sum of the tracts in Baylor plus the Sum  
of the tracts in Archer equals 4089 acres  
and the 11.5 acres in B B B Co no 2 in Baylor and the  
204.9 in Archer are not any part of the 4089  
acres.

I hope you will not be offended at me  
for making all the estimates for each County  
in each of the several surveys

I hope this data will prove satisfactory
