Dear Sir:

Your correspondence, with sketches, pertaining to the re-survey of the boundary line between Archer and Baylor counties thru the T E & L Company surveys, has been referred to the Abstract department.

It is found that the original fieldnotes touching the line thru these tracts of land call for 320 acres, while your re-survey calls for 323.8 acres, making an excess of 3.8 acres, hence in the absence of corrected fieldnotes the abstract will be corrected to show the area in each county as your sketch shows, less 2 acres to each county in each survey, bringing the total down to 320 acres as shown by the original notes made in 1853, and from which patents were issued.
