Field Notes of a portion of Bee Co line

To the Hon Co Court of Bee County
Gentlemen:

In accordance with a contract entered into between your predecessors in office and myself I have proceeded to run and establish the North boundary, the S.W. Boundary, the South Boundary and the S.E. Boundary lines of Bee County, and herewith tender to your honorable body the result of my labors together with a map of the same.

I began at a given point on the Medio creek designated as the point where the Mr. Lomis Survey (upper line) crosses said creek thence south 70°W 11 miles. Thence south 27° 8' 37 miles and 72800 to a point from which the junction of the Aransas and Pascua bears North 51° 8' 11 miles 34300.

Thence South 78° 40' E. 15 miles + 77400, thence N. 36 East 3 miles to the point where the Popalote creek empties into the Aransas River which completed my part of the Contract.

Field Notes

Beginning at a stake set in the bed of the Medio creek at the point where the upper line of the Mr. Lomis Survey crosses said creek from which a Mosquito tree 4 in dia standd ~~at~~ N. 28 W 9000

Thence S. 70 W at 1.000 ft a small ravine along a Mosquito country x x x x x x x x x x x x x x at 7160 ft Puent de la Peadra (general course south) at 7600 the Oakville and Helena Road x x x x x x at 15.820 ft a Road x x x x

and if the old lines and corners
can be identified, they should
be adopted. The shortest way
to trace the old line would be
to begin at the mouth of Pipeclot
Creek - thence $93^{\circ} 10'$ N 9 miles -
thence $N 78^{\circ} 40' W$ 15 miles 776 m.

That portion of the line of Bee
Co. not contained in these field
notes and lying between the mouth
of Pipeclot Creek and the corner
of Goldac & Refugio Co on Palanc
Creek is much needed by this
