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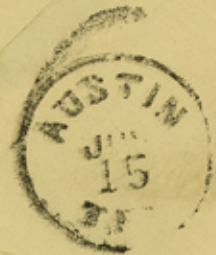

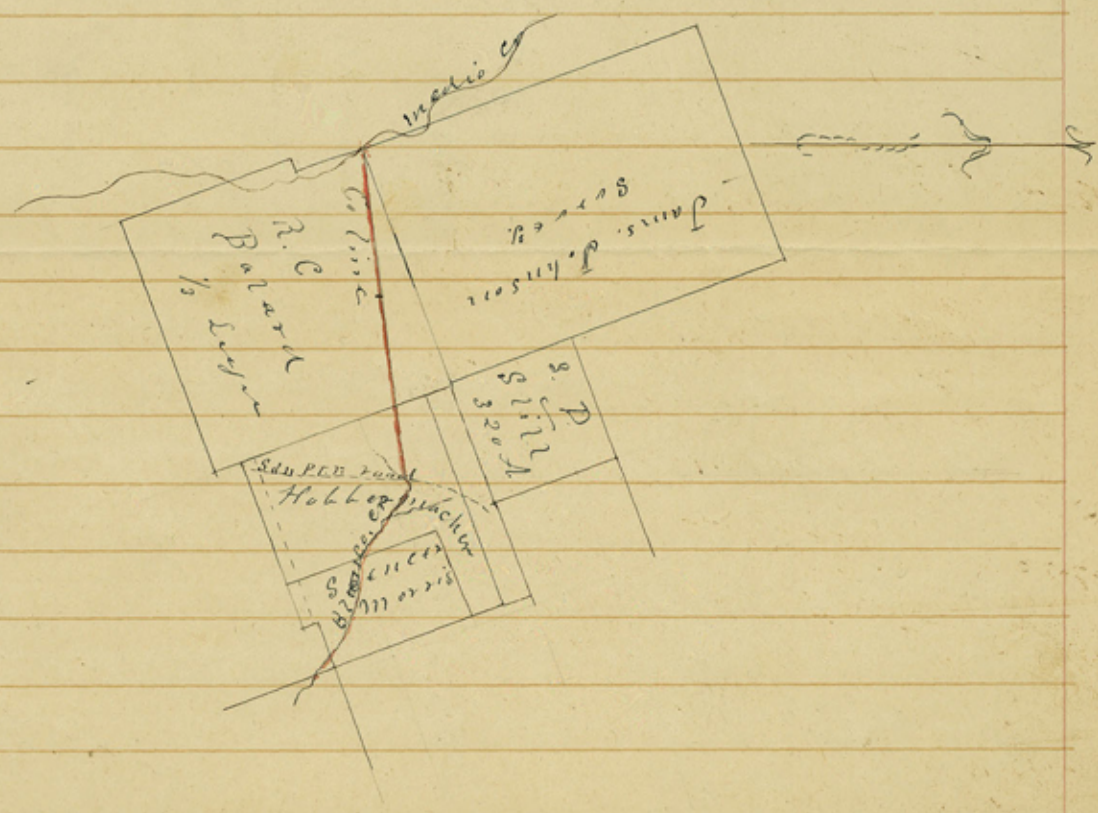

Having been appointed by your Honorable  
on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of April 1883 to survey and es-  
tablish the Boundary line of Harris & Bee Counties  
being that portion of Bee & Harris County  
between the Medio Creek and the Blanco Creek  
proceeded to the place appointed for the Com-  
mencement of said survey and in conjunction  
with W. R. Finner the Surveyor appointed to  
Represent Bee County in establishing said  
line began the work - we first ascertain by  
a trial line from the point where the old San-  
pablo's road crossed a west prong of the  
Blanco creek to the S.W. corner of the James  
Johnson Survey on the Medio what Degree  
of the Compass would connect these points -  
and found that Degree to be  $N 82^{\circ} \frac{3}{4} E$  which we  
adopted and then began at the S.W. Cor of the  
James Johnson Survey on the N Bank of the Medio  
Creek a post & mound whence a Suckling 14 in  
dia marked P. Co.  $S 87^{\circ} \frac{1}{2} W 15$  or and a Suckling 12  
in dia mound K Co.  $S 23^{\circ} \frac{1}{2} W 14$  or and another  
mound B Co.  $S 59^{\circ} W 20$  or thence  $N 82^{\circ} \frac{3}{4} E$  at 2685  
or intersected the S.E. Boundary of the R. C. Ballard  
Survey 581 or  $S 20^{\circ} E$  of the N.W. corner of the same at 3472  
or placed the corner of Bee & Harris Counties on  
the west prong of Blanco Creek at the point where  
the old Sanpablo's road from Helena crossed  
the same whence a musquiti 16 in dia mound K Co  
 $N 50^{\circ} \frac{3}{4} W 109$  or and a musquiti 4 in dia mound
