To the Hon. Commissioners Court, of Blanco Co.

In compliance with an order made by the Commissioners Court of Blanco Co. August Term. To establish the County line between this and Comal Co. I proceeded on October 17th 1884, to begin at S.W. cor. of Blanco Co. which is the S.E. cor. of Kendall Co., the place appointed for me to meet the County Surveyor of Comal Co. After comparing field notes and examining said beginning cor. we began our survey the next day Oct. 18th. Beginning at a st. mds. from where a S.O. 15 br. N 15° W 107 10. mked B and a S.O. stump 14 brs. S 74¹/₂ 45 W. This cor. is on line of Comal Co. and 5 Miles N 45¹/₂ E from where Cimarron Creek enters the Guadalupe River as certified to by D.W. Brady Co. Sur. Kendall Co. August 24 to 29th 1880. Beginning at the above described cor. Thence N 45¹/₂ E using Variation q^o/4 we ran a random line to the N.E. cor. of Comal Co. and S.W. cor. of Hays Co. 9 Miles and 1580 vs.

We found that a line run N 45¹/₂ E using Variation 8° 40' E would connect said S.W. cor. Blanco Co. and S.W. cor. of Hays, which is the N.E. cor. of Comal Co. where we found a st. mds. in center of Little Blanco from where a Cypress 16 brs. N 61³⁵ 1/2 50 W. and a Hackberry 10 brs. N 48³ 1/2 50 W. both mked X. This cor. was established according to record of Comal Co. records of the General Land Office by C.A. Gross representing Comal Co. and Jas. O. Goss repre. Hays Co. filed July 24 1882. It appears that Blanco Co. was not represented when these cor. were established, this last named cor. being an agreed cor. between Hays and Comal Cos.

Following are the field notes of the line established by us, many of the old surveys can only be recognized by st. mds. and fences.

Beginning at S.W. cor. of Blanco Co. st. mds. in field from where a S.O. 15 br. N 15° W 107 10. mked B. and a S.O. stump 14 brs. S 74¹/₂ 45 W.

Thence N 45¹/₂ E using Variation 8° 40' E, marking line with 5 chops and making connections of surveys divided by and near County line at 600 W. Blanco and San Antonio Road, also west line of survey No 40 for Fred Schaefer & Co. east line of survey No 27 for S.M. Fowler. set st. pile 2 feet high where Co. line crosses said road. Thence across field and little Blanco River mks S 7 1/2 E at 1240 vs. center of little Blanco at 1580 vs. st. md. in center from where a Cypress 16 bn. N 67 1/2 S 50 W. mked E a Hackberry 10 bs.
