Said W. S. McClung having been authorized to make said survey, and said survey having been examined by the Court and it appearing to the Court that said Survey is a correct and was truly made.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the same be entered on the Minutes of the Court.

Field Notes of a Survey of a connecting line

and standard parallel made for Borden and Howard Counties by virtue of an order of the County Court of Borden County, passed at the regular February term of said Court on the 11th day of February 1908, and an order of the County Court of Howard County passed at the regular term of said Court on the 29th day of February, 1908, concurring with the said County Court of Borden County for the purpose of establishing the South of boundary line said Borden County, and North boundary line of said Howard County.

We the undersigned surveyors met as directed by the order of said courts on the 30th day of March, 1908, at the South West corner of Jones County, same being the North West corner of Taylor County.

Said corner is a large stone marked S L J C W 30 S W C situated in the head of a small ravine 1060 varas S.75° W and 55 varas N.14 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. from the S. E. corner of Survey No. 283 in the name of Robt. Spears as established by the T. & P. Ry. Co.

We identified said South West corner of Jones County and began by sitting a stake with tack in top 2.13 feet South of said corner and by observation on polaris determined and established a true Meridian, by the Meridian thus established magnetic declination 10° 58' E.

(March 31st, 1908, we turn angle from the Meridian thus established to the
1ST. (secant N.89° 58' 20" W. and proceed with line on secant at 1901 varas set
(hub in form on secant at its intersecting with standard parallel.

(Continuing line on secant N.89° 58' 50" W. passing through farm and grove of
2ND. (mesqt. 1901 varas set a stake 1.27 feet South of secant on standard par-
(allel in yard of farm house.


(Continuing line on secant N. 89° 59' 30" W. passing over point of rocky
3RD. (hill 1901 varas set a stake 1.70 feet South of secant on standard parallel.

(Continuing line on secant West descending hill 1901 varas set a stake in

We secured a sand stone 2 feet x 6 inches dress the face of stone and
draw two lines across the face of same crossing each other at right
angles. Place said stone in pit North of hub. The center of said stone
at the intersection of the lines being placed 2.13 feet North of hub
on secant. The S. W. corner of stone mkd. Howard Co. The N. W.
quarter of said stone is marked Borden Co. W.S.Mc and the date 1908
on West half of same. We placed the said stone for the N. W. Corner
of Howard County and the S. E. corner of Borden County. We set
a stone in ground on South side of corner stone and against same 2½ feet
x 1 foot by 6 inches mkd. L X M W . set another stone 2½ feet x 1 foot
x 5 inches marked E L B C on West face 60 varas North of corner set
another stone 2½ feet x 1 foot x 5 inches marked E L H C on West face.
60 varas South from corner. From said corner a large stone set in the
ground in a large stone mound brs. N. 38° 56' W. 647 varas a pit filled
with broken stone where a large stone is placed in 1907 by H. W.
Stonham for the N. W. Corner of Mitchell County brs. N. 15° 45' W.

43rd (and Colorado wagon road in lane about 350 varas South of bridge
(passing through farm 1901 varas erect a stone mound on parallel
(at intersection with secant on side of rocky hill

(Turn angle from Meridian to secant checked to precision and continue
23rd (line on secant S.89 58'30" W. passing through farm crossing drain
(course North 1901 varas set a stake on secant at intersection with
(parallel on West slope of rocky ridge.

24th (passing over ridge and crossing an other branch 1901 varas set a stake
(in field 2.13 feet North of secant on parallel.

26th (ascending rocky slope crossing small canyon 1901 varas set a stake
(on parallel 1.27 feet South of secant.

(Continuing line on secant N.89 59'30" W. crossing two small canyons
27th (1901 varas set a stake on parallel 1.27 feet South of secant in head
(of small canyon.

(Continuing line on secant West crossing wagon road in lane Co. N. & S.
28th (crossing another wagon road in lane Co. E. & W. 1901 varas set a stake
(on parallel 1.27 feet South of secant in open prairie.

(Continuing line on secant S.89 59'30" W. over open prairie 1901 varas
29th (set a stake on parallel at intersection with secant.

(Continuing line on secant S.89 58'50" W. crossing wagon road in lane
30th (Co. N. & S. 1901 varas set a stake on parallel 2.13 feet North of secant
(from which the S. W. Cor. of Fisher County as placed by J.P. Bayley hrs.
(N.23 42' W. 377 varas.

(April 7th, 1908.

(Night before being cloudy could not get observation on polaris.

(We turn to new secant from former line and continued line N.89 58'
31st (20" W. at 498 varas cross the Roscoe-Snyder and Pacific Rail Road
(course S42 57'E. and N.42 57'W. at 1901 varas set a stake on parallel
(at its intersection with secant in open prairie, firm dark soil.

(Continuing line N.89 58'50" W. 1901 varas set a stake on West slope
32nd (1.27 feet South of secant on parallel open prairie, firm dark soil.

- (1.27 feet South of secant on East slope in sandy soil Mesquite timber
- 15th (Continuing line on secant N.89 59'30" W. passing through farm 1901 varas set a stake on parallel 1.70 feet South of secant in valley firm soil Mesquite timber.
- (Continuing line on secant West at 388 varas cross the Kansas City Orient and Mexico Railway Co. N. & S. at 1660 varas cross a wagon road in a lane North of a bridge crossing a branch and crossing a creek twice 1901 varas set a stake on parallel 1.27 feet South of secant.
