County of Borden and Field Notes of a Survey of a standard County of Howard I Parallel and the South boundary line of Borden County and North Boundary line off Howard County made for Borden and Howard Counties by virtue of an order of the County Court of Borden County passed at the regular February term of said Court on the 11th day of February, 1908, and order of the County Court of Howard County, passed at the regular February term of the County Court of Howard County on the 29th day of February, 1908, concurring with the County Court of Borden County for the purpose of establishing the South boundary line of Borden County and the North boundary line of Howard County.

We the undersigned surveyors appointed by the order of the abovementioned Courts, began April 14th, 1908, at the South East corner of Borden County, the same being the North East corner of Howard County, as established by us on the 13th day of April, 1908, as described in field notes of standard parallel and connecting line Sixty miles from the South West corner of Jones County.

Said S. E. Corner of Borden County and N. E. corner of Howard County, being a flat stone 2 feet X 2 feet X 6 inches placed in pit with surface of stone on level with surface of ground and marked by a line running through face of stone North and South, and a line crossing it at center of stone at right angle. The N. W. Quarter of stone is marked Borden Co.W.S.Mc and the S. W.quarter of stone is marked Howard Co. and date 1908, on West half of stone. From said corner.stone a large stone in large stone mound brs. N. 38 36 W. 647 varas a pit filled with broken stone where a large stone was placed in 1907, by W. H. Stoneham, for the N. W. Corner of Mitchell County brs.
