County — the line dividing the County
of McLennan and Bosque was run as
follows — Beginning at a point 15 miles
above Waco as directed by the law (scattering)
Bosque and McLennan County on the
West Bank of the Brazos for the S.W. corner
of Bosque County — from which a Cotton
Wood marked S.W. Cor. bears $S. 28^{\circ} E$ 3 1/2
varas and an other Cotton Wood marked
N.E. Cor. bears $N. 38. W.$ 3 varas — running
from thence — S. 65^W crossing Childers Creek
passing the house of W. H. Everett — on the route
at 12 1/2 miles to North Bosque and the Survey
of J. Mc Lennan thence North of the residence
of J. H. Bloodworth crossing Hog Creek on the
Survey in the name of Johnson — Crossing
Middle Bosque on the Survey in the name of
Garcia and intersected the line of
Coryell County
