To Hon John Belove County Judge of Brazoria Co

We find S Robbins County Surveyor of Matagorda County and Robt B Harris County Surveyor of Brazoria County in obedience to an order of the County Judge of Matagorda County to run the County line between the Counties of Matagorda and Brazoria, and the order of the County Judge of Brazoria County to assist in running the same, began said line on the 7th day of April 1887, of which the following is the field notes.

Beginning at a Stake in the center of Cedar Lake Creek from which a Live Oak 2 ft in dia MK² ~~M²~~ ^{m^{co}} bns S 79^{1/2}° W 9^{1/2}° vs and another Live Oak MK² BC² ~~B²~~ bns N. 52^{1/2}° 10' W 12' vs Three West at 1090. vs an Ash 3 ft in dia. MK² MC², BC². At 1900 vs a Stump marked 1 At 1910 vs an Elm 1 ft in dia marked X bns 8 2 ft At 3440 vs an ash 2 ft. in dia marked MC² bns 8. C. inches At 3441 vs N.E. end line of the Tone and Jamison League At 3792 vs an ash 2 ft in dia marked M² bns 8 1/2" w At 3804 vs a Pine Oak 18 ins in dia marked B² bns N 1/2° vs At 5682 vs the R.W. line of the Tone and Jamison League a Live Oak 10 ins. in dia MK² ~~M²~~ bns E ft. At 5700 vs a Stake from which a box Elder 12 ins. in dia MK² M² B. bns W. 5 vs At 6570 vs a Live Oak 4 ft in dia MK² MC², BC²; At 6882 vs a road 3 vs N of a Hackberry MK² MC², At 7600 vs a Stake from which an Elm bns N. 60²-25' E 4^{1/2} vs and another bns S 60²-25' W 3^{1/2} ^{1/2} vs At 7644 vs a Stake at edge of water in Lynville Bogon, from which an ash 2 ft in dia MK² BC² bns N 5²-15' E 7^{1/2} vs an Elm 15 ins in dia MK² ~~M²~~ bns. S 5²-15' W 18^{3/10} vs at 7654 vs the center of Lynville Bogon where it is impracticable to put a Stake, This point is more definitely located by running a line N 45² W 578 vs to the S.E. line of the North Quarter of the R H Williams League at a point N. 45² E 3^{1/2} from a Mulberry Stake from which an Elm bns S 30² W 5 vs, & do N 24² E, 4 vs. both marked X said Stake being 20 vs N. E. of the center


