BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 25th day of May 1920, at a regular term of this court the above styled and numbered cause came on to be heard, and the Plaintiff and defendant both appeared by attorneys and announced ready for trial, and a jury having been waived, the case was submitted to the Court, and the Court on said 25th day of May, 1920, after hearing the evidence, the law and argument of counsel, found that the boundary line between Pecos and Brewster County if ever marked, had become indefinite and undefined, and could not be found upon the ground, and that it was necessary to re-mark and re-survey said line, and thereupon on said 25th day of May 1920 this court entered a judgment ordering said line between Pecos County and Brewster County to be surveyed and marked and appointed Robert E. Estes, Surveyor to survey and mark said line, and said judgment directed said Estes, surveyor, to run said line in accordance with the report and survey made by Thos. C. Nelson on file in this court, beginning at the mouth of San Francisco Creek where it empties into the Rio Grande River and run in a North-westerly direction on a direct and straight line to Barella Springs, and to place posts, mounds or stone monuments marking said line, and if posts are placed along said, the same to be of hued cedar, cypress or bois darc, at least 8 inches in diameter, five feet long, and set in the ground not less than three feet, and if mounds of stones are placed along said line, the same not to be less than two feet high, and said monuments to be placed at the end of each mile in said boundary line, and the initial corners shall be described on said posts or monuments so established; said line, however, only to be so marked on the part of said line that constitutes the boundary line between Pecos County and Brewster County. Said judgment being as follows:

On this the 25th day of May 1920, came on to be heard the above styled and numbered cause, and the Plaintiff appearing by attorneys and the Defendant also appearing by attorneys and all parties having announced ready for trial and a jury having been waived the case was submitted to the Court and the Court after hearing the evidence, the law read and argument of counsel, is of the opinion that the boundary line between Plaintiff and Defendant is not a definite and marked boundary line; and that it is necessary to have the said boundary line surveyed and marked on the ground.

Therefore, it is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that Robert E. Estes, a competent surveyor be and he is hereby appointed to survey the boundary line between Plaintiff and Defendant in accordance with the report made by Thos. C. Nelson, on file in this court, beginning at the mouth of San Francisco Creek, where it empties into the Rio Grande River and running in a north-westerly direction on a direct and straight line to Barella Springs, and shall place posts, mounds or stone monuments marking said line and if posts are placed along said line, the same shall be of hewn cedar, cypress or bois d'arc, at least 8 inches in diameter, five feet long and set in the ground not less than three feet, and if mounds of stone are placed along said line, same shall not be less than two feet high and said monuments to be placed at the end of each mile in said boundary line and the initial corners shall be described on said posts or monuments so established. Said line, however, only to be so marked on part of said line that constitutes the boundary line between Pecos and Brewster County.

That said surveyor shall notify the County Judge of Pecos County and the County Judge of Brewster County, by registered mail at least fifteen (15) days in advance of the date of the beginning of said survey and giving the time and place in said notices that he will begin said survey.

And said surveyor shall file his said report in this Court at least thirty (30) days before the next term of this court, and shall send the County Judge of Brewster County and the County Judge of Pecos County each a true copy of said report, by registered mail not less than twenty-five (25) days before the next term of this court.

That said surveyor shall receive a reasonable compensation for such work and report to be fixed by the Court.

And that this case is now continued to the next term of this Court, for the purpose of having the above survey made <sup>and</sup> the cause finally determined and pending a final order in this cause it is ordered that the Tax Assessor and Collector of Brewster County proceed to assess and collect the taxes on the property in the disputed territory and pay sum into the registry of this court subject to the further orders of this Court.

Plaintiff in open court excepts to each and every portion of this order.

And whereas the said Robert E. Estes did survey said boundary line under said judgment and did file his report of said survey in this court on the 23rd day of October 1920, and this cause came on to be heard on December 22, 1920, at regular term of this court and plaintiff and defendant both appeared by attorneys and announced ready for trial, and a jury having been waived, the case was submitted to the Court, and the court on said December 22, 1920, after hearing the evidence, the law, and argument of counsel, found the report of said surveyor and the survey made by said surveyor are in all things in compliance with the judgment of this court theretofore entered, ordering said line to be re-surveyed and remarked and said report of said surveyor and said survey so made by said surveyor was approved by judgment of this court on said December 22nd, 1920, and this Court in said judgment ordered said surveyor to in addition to the said survey to tie said survey of said boundary line to any prominent natural objects crossed by, or adjacent to said boundary line as well as of the corners and lines of survey on or near boundary line, and to make report of same at next term of this court, said judgment being as follows:

NOVEMBER TERM A.D. 1920.

On this 22nd day of December 1920, the above cause coming on to be heard on the motion of the plaintiff to reject the report of the surveyor heretofore appointed by this court to survey and mark on the ground the true boundary line between the Plaintiff, Pecos County and the defendant, Brewster County, and after considering the same, and after hearing testimony and being fully advised in the premises, the Court overrules said motion. But it appearing to the Court that said report does not tie said boundary line to any prominent natural objects crossed by, or adjacent to said boundary line as well as of the corners and lines of survey on or near said boundary line, so as to determine the question of the position of the survey mentioned in plaintiff's pleading as to what county said surveys are situated in, it is therefore the order of the Court that said court surveyor, Robt. E. Estes, be and he is hereby ordered to locate along said County line established by him all natural objects crossed by, or adjacent to, said boundary line, as well as of the corners and lines of said surveys on or near said boundary line, and to file his supplemental report and map in this court thirty days before the next term of this court and said report and map shall further show the acreage of each tract of land intersected by said County line that is situated in each respective county or field notes by which said acreage can be made definite. And he is further ordered to furnish the respective County Judges of the plaintiff and the defendant a copy of this report and map at the same time he files the original in this court.

And it is further ordered that this case be continued until the next term of this court for the purpose of considering said report.

It is the further order of the Court that the costs of this case accrued to date on account of said report of said surveyor be borne and paid by the plaintiff and defendant in equal amounts, there being the sum of \$1754.55 due according to said report. And the said taxing of costs at this time shall not be final, but all costs herein incurred shall be finally taxed upon the final hearing hereof, and any

sums paid under this order shall abide the said final taxation of costs, and any costs paid by either plaintiff or defendant contrary to such final adjudication and taxation of the costs herein shall be returned to such party so paying same.

To all of which the plaintiff and defendant, in open court excepted.

And wherefore, the said Robert E.Estes did locate along said County line established by him all natural objects crossed by or adjacent to said boundary line, also the corners of lines of said surveys on or near said boundary line, and did file his supplemental report and map in this court as directed by this court and in the time set out showing the work done by him and the acreage of each tract of land intersected by said county line that is situated in each respective county, and in all things complying with the order of the court.

And this cause was at the April term 1921 of this court continued by agreement on application of the plaintiff.

And whereas, on this 19th day of December A.D.1921, came on to be heard the said cause and said last mentioned report and map of said surveyor, and the plaintiff and defendant appeared by attorneys and announced ready for trial, and a jury having been waived the cause was submitted to the court, and the court having heard the evidence, the law and the argument of counsel and after duly considering said report and map of said surveyor, it is the opinion of this court that the same are in all respects made in accordance with the judgment of this court and shows the true acreage on each side of said county line of all surveys crossed by said line, and is tied to prominent natural objects, corners and lines of surveys along said line.

It is therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court that the boundary line between Pecos County, plaintiff, and Brewster County, defendant, both of said Counties being in the State of Texas, be and the same is hereby established according to the survey made of same by Robert Estes, surveyor, under order of this court, and the filed notes of said survey so established are as follows:

Begining: at a stone monument 3 ft. high on high bluff 550 ft. above the bed of the Rio Grande, and on the West side of the mouth of San Francisco creek where it empties into the Rio Grande, on the border between the United States and Mexico.
