each homestead for him  
which you know is very unjust

Please give this matter your  
early attention and greatly oblige  
the settlers of this county as well  
as myself

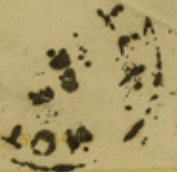
