Burnet County, Texas. }

J. F. A. Chamberlain

Surveyor of Burnet County Texas, having been appointed by your Honorable body to proceed in conjunction with the Surveyor appointed by the Commissioners Court of Travis County, to survey and ascertain the boundary line between Burnet and Travis Counties, beg leave to submit the following report, to wit:

The Travis County Surveyor having failed to meet me at the time and place appointed, I proceeded to run said line, alone as the law directs in such cases: Of which survey the following are the field notes:

Beginning on the line of Burnet and Williamson Counties as established by E. J. Moses Survey of Burnet County, and C. Morelle Surveyor of Williamson County, on the 8th day of September 1880: at the seventh mile past from the beginning Corner of Burnet County as established by said Surveyors;

I find the S. line of the Mix and Manuel surveys plainly marked with very old hacks as also the line between said surveys, the same being the west line of the John Caruthers League and I find no lines corresponding with the calls of the field notes except those above described. I find no corner corresponding with the calls for the S.W. Cor. of said Caruthers League. - though I searched diligently for $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile N. 71° E. from said Corner and I find no trees with bearing marks to suit except at the Corner above described as the S. E. Cor. of the Mix. Survey.



Burnet County Texas. }

I beg leave to submit the following as evidence of the Correctness of the beginning Corner of Burnet County: as I find a difference of about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile between the line of Burnet and Williamson Counties as run by John Harvey in 1853, and the said line as run by Mases and Morelle in 1880.

Beginning at the N. Cor. of the John Caruthers League from which I find a b.O. with a very old blaze. bearing S. 20° W. 30 vs. a Young Span. Oak. growing from an old stump. brs S. 57° W. 36 vs. instead of 46 vs as called for, and the N. W. Cor of the W. H. Magill Sur. brs N. 80 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ vs. = Thence S. 71° W. 215. vs a Br. 1033 vs. the N. San Gabriel, 1508. vs. the S. W. Cor of the John Bailey Lea. 3599, vs. the Cor at which John Harvey began the survey of the County line; Whence a b.O. marked B.C. brs N. 26° E. 113. vs. at 5055. vs. the N. W. Cor of said Caruthers Lea. marked by a Post set by Mases and Morelle as the beginning Corner of said County line; Thence S. 19° E. 3644 vs. a Branch 5143. vs the S. E. Cor. of the Nat Mix. Sur a St-Mid whence a b.O. brs N. 30° E. 33 vs. instead of 30 vs as called for in the field notes of the Juan Manuel Sur. and a do. brs S. 40° E. 32 vs. instead of 34 vs. as called for in said field notes. - Thence S. 71° W. 2120 vs. a Branch 2998. vs. the S.
