To the Honorable Commissioners Court,
Burnet County, Texas:

J. J. A. Chamberlain Surveyor of
Burnet County, having been appointed by
your Honorable body on the 15th day of
May 1883, to survey, in conjunction with
the Surveyor of Lampasas County,
the boundary line between Burnet and
Lampasas Counties, having proceeded at
the time, and in the manner directed, to run,
mark, and establish said line; he leave
to submit the following field notes and
accompanying plat as my report of
the same; both Surveyors agreeing thereto,
to-wit:

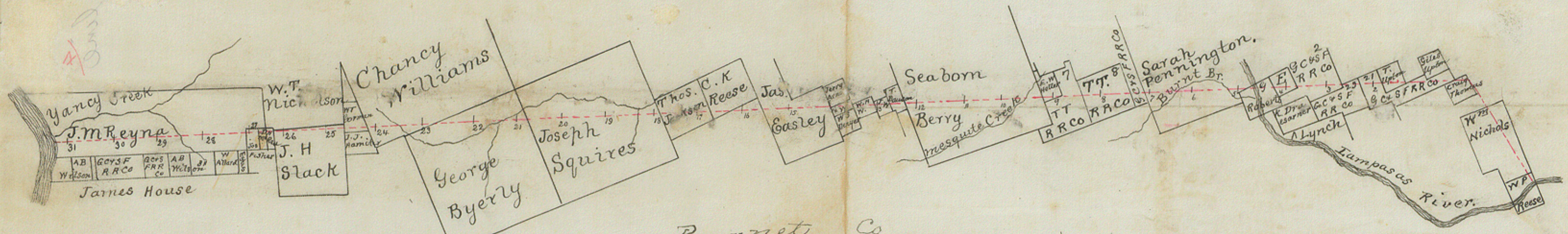
