Commissioners Court of Burnet County, Texas:

I, J. A. Chamberlain, County Surveyor
of Burnet County, having been appointed by
your Honorable Body, on the 11th day of November,
1884, to survey, in conjunction with the
Surveyor of Blanco County, the Boundary
Line between Burnet and Blanco Counties,
beg leave to submit the following as my
report of said survey:

I met Capt. P. F. Appell, County
Surveyor of Blanco County, at Corwin, on
the 26th day of February 1885, being the time and
place designated for our meeting; but the S. W.
corner of Llano County being the termination
of our line and not being at that time
established, we were forced, after making
a commencement, to postpone our work
until the establishment of said corner could
be effected; after which we met again by
agreement, on the 22^d day of September 1886
and after running a random line and
ascertaining thereby the course of the true
line to be N. 72° 2' W. we proceeded to run
mark and establish the boundary line
between said Counties, both Surveyors
agreeing thereto, of which line the following
field notes and accompanying plat

are a correct representation, to wit:

Beginning at the S.E. cor. of Burnet County as established by a Survey of the Burnet and Travis County line made in February 1885; the same being the N.E. cor. of Blanco County; a Stone Mound Four Miles South of the Colorado River, whence a L.O. brs. S. 83° E. 5 vs. do. brs. N. 88° W. 6 vs.

Thence N. $72^{\circ} 2'$ W. at 338 vs. a Ravine, at 552 vs. the W. line of the A. & L. Shaffer Survey No. 57, 255 vs. South of the S.W. cor. of the M. C. Salinas Sur. No. 17 and 167 vs. North of the cor. of said Shaffer Sur. on the N.E. line of the M. 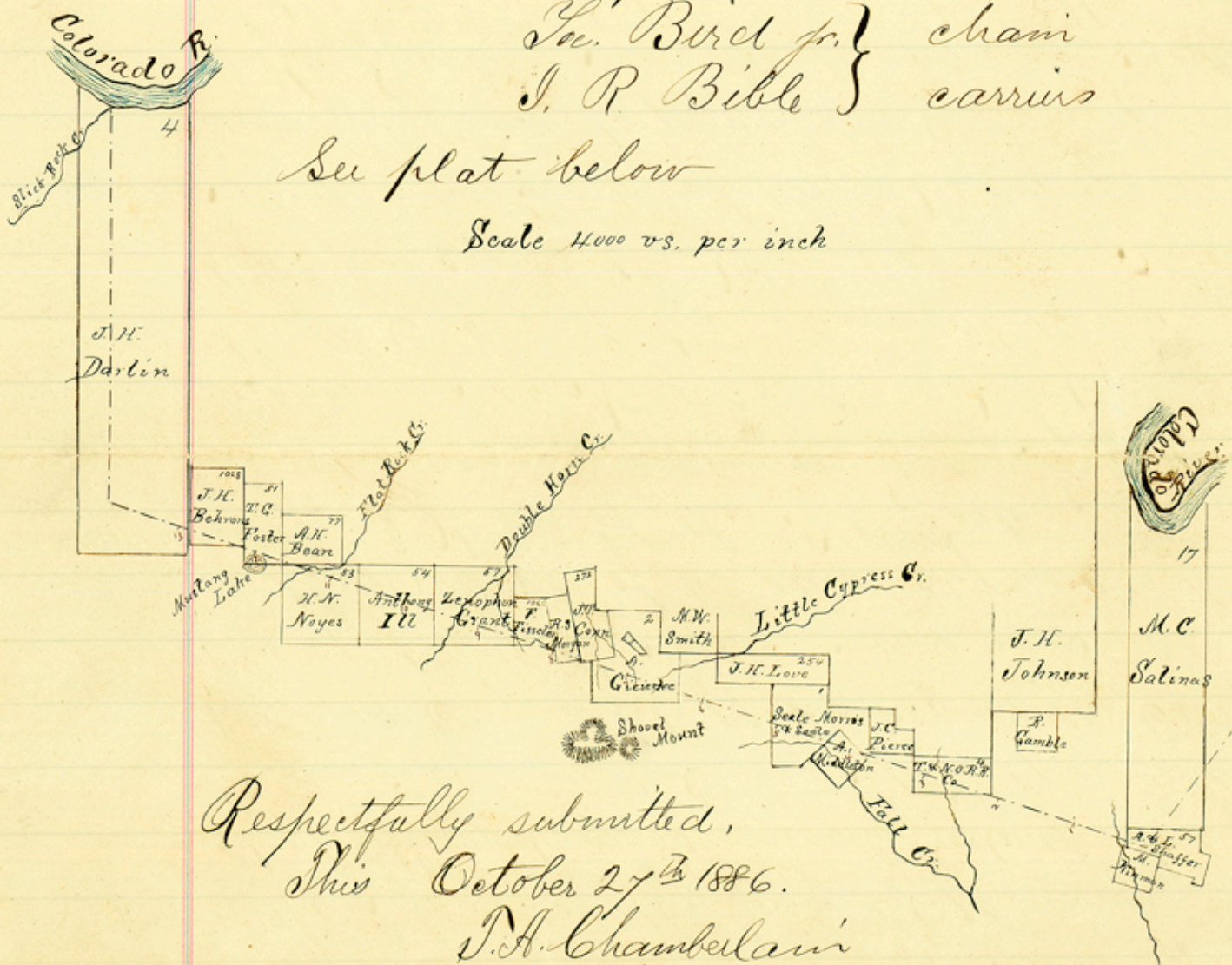
