I, J. A. Chamberlain Surveyor of Burnet
County, Texas, having been appointed by
your Honorable Body on the 11th day of
November 1884 to assist in surveying
the line of Burnet and Travis Counties
beg leave to submit the following as my
report of said Survey

I went on Feb. 23^d 1885 to the N. E. cor.
of the Allison Williams Survey, the time
and place appointed for me to meet
the Travis County Surveyor, but said
Surveyor failing to be present I proceeded
as directed by law to make the Survey
alone, of which the following are the field
notes, to-wit: Beginning where the line
of Burnet and Travis Counties intersects
the North or left bank of the Colorado
River at a Post set by me in
surveying said County line in 1882

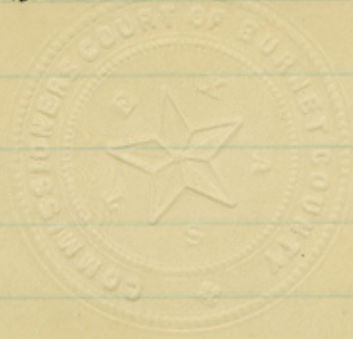

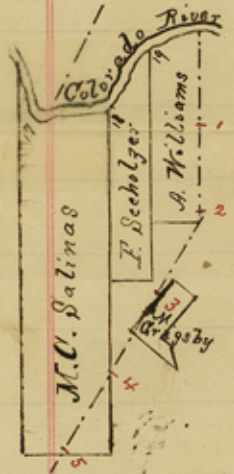
