The North line from establish. d  
Cor. to Cor. was found by actual  
measurement 31 miles -  
The S.W. Cor. being 1751 vts W  
of a true S. line from N.W. Cor.  
The S.E. Cor. being established  
by the projection of an E. line fr.  
the S.W. Cor. and a South line fr.  
the N.E. Cor. making length of  
South line 31 mi + 1715 vts  
As the corners had been previ-  
ously established and approved the  
discrepancies could not be rem-  
edied

Thursday, March 14<sup>th</sup> 1901.

Begin at an earth mound and 4 pits identified as marking  
60<sup>th</sup> mile south from NW corner Hansford county by bearings  
on Jno Ray peak S 77° 32' W Cottonwood on North  
Turkey creek N 0° 19' E. Point of bluff North of  
Jno Ray S 79° 30' W - Round knoll end of bluff N 87° W.  
Thence South - (variation of needles at 8 AM - 10 58 E)  
476 vs zinc cone marked Patter, - Carson - Hutchinson -  
Moore - for common corner to the four Counties named.  
Thence East - 1900.8 vs earth mound 2ft high and 2 pits and  
iron pipe 1 1/2 x 36" marked 1-29 - C-H - on west slope of small  
sandy hill, for first mile.

East - 1025 1/2 vs N.W. 4 wire fence. - 1900.8 vs earth mound

wagon road - 805 vs deep ravine. - 1100 vs ravine - 1900.8 vs earth mound  
2ft high and 2 pits and iron pipe 1 1/2 x 36" marked 6-24 - C-H - on level side - 6<sup>th</sup> mile.

point the iron pipe at NW corner sec 121, Blk 5, A & G. N. R.R.C. is
