



The State of Texas, Field notes of a survey

 of Jefferson County, made in accordance  
 with an order of the Hon. Commis-  
 sioner Court of Chambers County  
 made and entered August 29th  
 1881, Beginning at a point on  
 the line of Liberty & Chambers  
 Counties at the edge of  
 Turtle Bayou Timber 1 1/2 m  
 N. of a blazed water oak and 3936  
 m. East of the point of intersection  
 of said line and the West line  
 of the Audan Thaus league;
