At the time the boundary line between Clay
and Jack Counties was run in 1876 I was
County Judge of Clay County and was present
when said line was established and
myself and Sam Green then Surveyor of
Clay County consented to draw the line
contended for by Josely Culloney Surveyor
of Jack County under protest, with the distinct
understanding that when ever the boundary
lines of the Counties east of this should be
definitely settled, that the line between Clay
and Jack should be made to conform
thereto

The fieldnotes of the Countyline between Clay and Jack Co: as run in 1876 are not on file in the Gen: Land Office. (For a copy of same see letter)

The fieldnotes of the Countylines of Wise County as run in 1856 were filed in the Gen: Land Office in 1858.

The fieldnote of the line between Clay and Montague Co: not returned.

Wise Co. begins at the S. W. corner of Denton Co. Thence North 30 miles. Thence West 30 miles - Thence South 30 miles etc.

Created January 1856.

Jack Co. begins on the S. W. corn. of Wise Co. Thence West to the Eastline of Young Co. Thence North 30 miles. Thence East to the N. W. corn. of Wise Co etc. Created August 1856.

Clay Co begins at the S. W. corner of Montague Co. Thence West with the Northline of Jack Co to its N. W. corner. Thence North etc. Created Decemb. 1856.

The corner described as the N. W. corner of Wise Co. in the fieldnotes of the Countylines is a Post oak 8 in. dia. mkd: N. W. C. W. C.

The fieldnotes of the Northline of Jack Co. (accompanying letter) describe the N. W. corner of Wise Co. as a pile of stone in a Creek valley on Stone mkd: N. W. cor. W. Co: y.

Dear Sir:

Answering your favor of the 26th ult., you are respectfully advised as follows, to wit:

Wise County is a County 30 miles square and the field notes of the county lines are on file in this office.

Jack Co., begins at the S.W. corner of Wise Co., thence West to the East line of Young Co., thence North 30 miles, thence East to the N.W. corner of Wise Co., thence South to the beginning. No fieldnotes of County line returned to Gen'l. Land Office.

Montague Co., begins 6 miles West of the N.E. corner of Wise County. Thence West with the North line of Wise and Jack Co., to a point 4 miles West of the N.E. corner of Jack Co., thence North etc.

Clay Co., begins at the S.W. corner of Montague Co., thence West with the North line of Jack Co., to the N.W. corner of said Co., etc.
