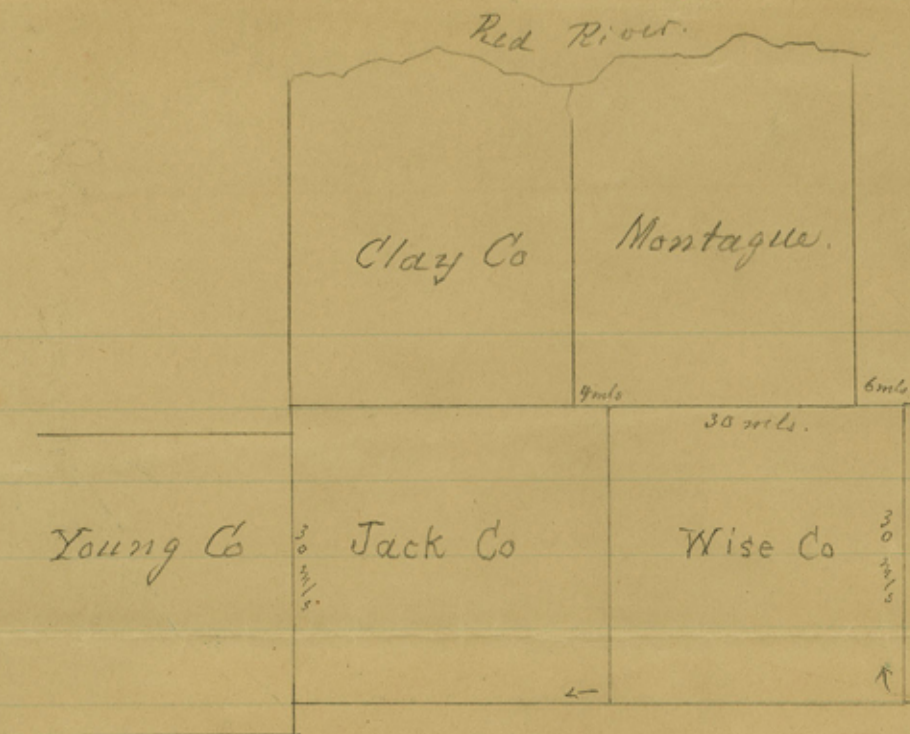

this office. The field notes of the County line between Clay and Montague Co., were filed in this office August 8/90 but they are only signed by the Clay Co., surveyor.

From this you will perceive that the lines of Wise County have heretofore been established. If the Northwest corner of Wise has been lost the same should be re-established by intersection of the North and West lines of said county, the Northeast corner of Jack will then have been established and the line between Jack & Clay should then be established by running due West from said corner.

Wise Co. is a County 30 miles square and the fieldnotes of the County lines are on file in this Office.

Jack Co. begins at the S.W. corner of Wise Co. thence West to the Eastline of Young Co. thence North 30 miles thence East to the N.W. corner of Wise Co. thence South to beginning. No fieldnotes of County lines returned to Genl Land Office.

Montague Co. begins 6 miles West of the N.E. corner of Wise County. Thence West with the Northline of Wise and Jack Co. to a point 4 miles West of the N.E. corner of Jack Co. thence North etc.

Clay Co. begins at the S.W. corner of Montague Co. thence West with the Northline of Jack Co. to the N.W. corner of said Co. etc.

There are no fieldnotes of Montague Co. lines on file in this Office.

The fieldnotes of the Countyline between Clay and Montague Co. were filed in this Office August 8/90. but they are only signed by the Clay Co. Surveyor.
