Now then I can't see that you can do any more but I want you to see our side. And we shall contend that the survey was so indefinitely that same amounts to no line at all. The "Big" of Clay is at S.W. cor of Mountain Co. I hear the stat fixes the matter, 2nd "The Big" cor of Jack is S.W. Cor wise - west to cor north 30 miles - thence E. to N.W. cor wise cor. How are they to get to N.W. cor of Wise Co?


