

Jack Co. claims that the line between Jack and Clay Co. was legally established by Samuel Green, Surveyor of Clay Co. and Wesley Calloway, Surveyor of Jack Co. in 1876. These field notes are not on file in the Genl Land Office.

It also claims that the lines of Wise Co. have been run several times. There are <sup>the field notes of</sup> only one survey of the lines on file in the Genl Land Office, which was run by L. E. Campbell in 1856. and which makes the Westline of Wise County 29 miles 1790 or long (or 110 or short)

The copy of the field notes of the North line of Jack County by Green and Calloway attached describes the N. W. corner of Wise Co. as a pile of stones in a Creek valley; one of the stones mkd N. W. cor. W. Coty. while the field notes of Wise County run by Campbell describes it as a Post oak 8 in dia. mkd N. W. C. W. C. in a Creek valley.

REGULAR TERM JULY 31st 1876.

Be it remembered that on the 31st day of July A.D. 1876 there was begun and held a regular term of the Honorable Commissioners Court of Clay County Texas at Henrietta. Present the Hon. W.B. Plonens, County Judge, Alex. Metzger, Cour of Precinct No. 3, Alex Dawson Cour Precinct No. 4, G.W. Alexander Clerk by his deputy W.W. Carrell, T.W. Gee Sheriff by his deputy R.L. Sears when the following proceedings were had to-wit:-

Samuel Green having been appointed by this Court at the April Term 1876 to run and locate the line between Clay and Jack Counties State of Texas and he Samuel Green made the following report
