

Be it remembered that on this the - day of - - A. D. 1890 there was begun and holden a call term of the Honorable Commissioners Court of Clay County, Texas, present and presiding Hon. Ben F. Turner County Judge D. L. Britain Commissioner Precinct No. 1. J. H. Durn Comr Preceinct No. 2 L. B. Brown Comr Precinct No. 3, and A. J. Farmer Comr. Prect No. 4 G. W. Ford, Co. Clerk and G. C. Wright Sheriff by T. W. Brannon deputy, Court was opened by proclamation of Sheriff by T. W. Brannon deputy when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Order No. I Now coming on to be heard the report of the surveyors appointed at the--- term of this Court of Montague County to survey, locate and establish the County line between Montague County and Clay County, and the report being read it is ordered that said report be approved and placed of record and that said line be recognized as the County boundary between Montague County and Clay County.

SURVEYORS REPORT

Field notes of County line established between Montague and Clay Counties by order of the Commissioners Court of said Counties.
