JUDGMENT

Be it known that on the 9th day of July, A. D., 1965, came on to be heard in the 52nd District Court of Comanche County, Texas, the above entitled and numbered cause, wherein the County of Coleman is Plaintiff and the County of Callahan and the County of Taylor are Defendants, and came the parties and their attorneys of record, and it appearing to the Court that this Court has jurisdiction of all matters in controversy, and that each of the Defendants have been duly cited in the manner and for the length of time required by law, and that this Court has jurisdiction of all parties to this cause, and that the Defendants have heretofore filed their respective answers to the Plaintiff's pleadings herein, and the Court having received the evidence in open Court in Comanche County, Texas, in the presence of all parties, and having heard the evidence, the argument of counsel, both written and oral, and being of the opinion that judgment should be given and rendered for Plaintiff as prayed for;

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the true boundary line between the County of Coleman, Plaintiff herein, and the Counties of Callahan and Taylor, the Defendants herein, be and the same is hereby established to be on and along that certain line surveyed by J. T. Evans on April 1, 2, 3, 4 and 6, in the year 1885, and as reported by the said J. T. Evans,

Surveyor, to the Commissioners' Court of Coleman County, Texas, in its May Term of 1885, and the field notes of said line being of record in Vol. C, pages 184-187 of the Commissioners' Court Minutes of Coleman County, Texas, and also being of record with the General Land Office of the State of Texas, all of which are here referred to for all purposes, such boundary line being heretofore established and marked in accordance with the above mentioned field notes, and which line can now be established and found on the ground, said line also being the line set forth by field mtes in Plaintiff's Original Petition, and it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the North boundary line of Coleman County, Texas, shall be over and across and along the field notes reported by the said J. T. Evans, as above described, and that said line shall also be the South line of Callahan County and the South line of Taylor County where such lines are common with the North boundary line of Coleman County, Texas, which line and the field notes thereof read and hereby established as follows, to-wit:
